SUBJECT: SLSS Lifesaving Championships Updated Information 2014

Further to Circular 23/13-14 this circular provides an update on the SLSS Lifesaving Championships. This circular includes information from the previous circular but also includes the timetable of events and notes changes to the resuscitation marking section. **Please note the Lifesaving Championships are now being conducted over 2 dates.**

LOCATION AND ENTRIES

The Lifesaving Championships will be held at Coogee Beach on Thursday 30 January 2014 and Saturday 1st February 2014

Thursday 30 January 2014 from 5.30pm – report by 6.30pm

To avoid lengthy delays on the Coogee Carnival day, the resuscitation component of the Champion Lifesaver event and the Patrol Championship will be held commencing at 5.30pm on Thursday 30 January on the ground floor of the Coogee SLSC. It will be conducted until around 9.30pm. Individuals may arrive from 5.30pm for the champion lifesaver resuscitation component and must have arrived by 6.30pm.

The draw for the Patrol Competition to determine individual positions will be conducted at 6.30pm with all Patrol Team members required to be in attendance.

Please note SLSA Bulletin 5/13-14 highlights changes to the resuscitation sections. A copy of the Circular and current marking guides are attached. These guides will be used in the judging the resuscitation component, and may be used for coaching purposes prior to event day.

Saturday 1st February 2014 - report 7.45am to Coogee Clubhouse

The Theory Paper for both events will commence at 8.00 am.

It is proposed to conduct the Patrol Championship task from 9am to approximately 11am. Access to the competition arena will be available from 11am to conduct physical event components. Further information will be provided on the day.

NOTE: The First Aid Competition Events (Open, U19, U17 & U15) will not be conducted on this date. Branch will advise via Circular of the Venue and Date for these events.

All events will be run in accordance with the current 34th Edition Surf Sports Manual and the 33rd Edition Public Safety and Aquatic Rescue Manual. A copy of Section 3 of the Surf Sports Manual - Lifesaving Events can be found at the following link http://www.slsa.com.au/default.aspx?s=adminresources&id=383 All Clubs should familiarise themselves in the conduct of these events. Clubs must be attired correctly as per the competition manual including the wearing of Club caps.

EQUIPMENT

- Competitors / Clubs will bring their own rescue boards, tubes, first aid kits, Air bag, swim fins, Resus masks and other equipment as required.
- Competitors/Clubs to provide Manikins, plastic bags, cleaning solution and masks and pen.

PRIZES

- Medals will be presented to First, Second & Third placegetters
- Points from event placings go towards the competition pointscore for the Open Branch Championships
- Rescue Boards and Rescue Tubes

LOCK DOWN

Teams and individuals are reminded that as part of some of the events a 'competitor lock down' will be required as part of competition as per the manual. During this time you may NOT be permitted to compete in other events. We will however ensure that the 'lock down' time is as short as possible.
