Prizes and Trophies:

- Club Point Score Cash Prizes of \$500 for 1st, \$300 for second and \$200 for 3rd. In the event of a dead heat in the point score the relevant cash prizes will be shared. All events conducted except the Beach event “plate” finals will be included in the point score.
- \$100 cash prize plus a special prize to the fastest male and female competitor in the Vici Shark Island Ski Race.
- \$100 cash prize plus a special prize to the winner of the Open Ironman and Open Ironwoman events.
- \$300 cash prize to the winner of the Open Male and Open Female Taplin Relay events.
- Prizes will be awarded to the winning individuals/teams of events marked with an asterisk.
- U15 – Open age group male and female competitor random draws for special prizes (minimum two per age and gender).

Supplementary Rules and Notes:

- Competition shall be conducted as per the current edition SLSA Surf Sports Manual except where detailed in this section.
- All competitors must have their age group clearly marked on their upper left arm.
- Marshalling closes for the Shark Island Ski Race at 8.15 am and for the first short course events at 8.45am.
- All competitors and handlers must wear pink fluorescent coloured singlets as their outer layer of clothing when entering the water.
- U/13 and U/14 age competitors holding a proficient Surf Rescue Certificate etc. may compete in U15 events.
- As per SLSA rules U/15 and under competitors are not permitted to compete in U17, U19 or Open age group events.
- The Club point score shall be 6 points for 1st through to 1 point for 6th. Dead heats will share the allotted placing points.
- All individual and team events will be conducted around the buoy courses set for the individual legs of Ironman/Ironwoman events.
- All events will be conducted in block (i.e. heats (where required) and finals immediately following).
- In all events except the Shark Island Ski Race U/19 aged competitors shall compete as Opens in the Open age category.
- The U/17 and Open age Surf Race will be conducted together and individual placings declared for each age group. Competitors will be marshalled in order of age across the start line.
- There will be no pre nomination of surf teams. The teams result will be determined by the first four club competitors (of any age where applicable) across the finish line. There can be more than one team from a club. **Note:** Dependent on the water conditions, and the provision of appropriate water safety, the Referee may approve more than 40 competitors in the Surf Race and Surf Teams events.
- The U/17 - Open Mixed Beach Relay shall consist of 4 runners from within that age range. There must be a minimum of two and maximum of three females in each team. Teams may select their own order of running.
- The U/15 Mixed Beach Relay shall consist of 4 runners from within that age range. There must be a minimum of two and maximum of three female in each team. Teams may select their own order of running.
- The Beach Sprint and Beach Flag events shall be run in pools with the top 8 progressing to an “A” final in each age category. Competitors not qualifying for the “A” final may contest “plate” finals. Club point score points will not be awarded in the “plate” finals.
- The Mixed Board Rescue races shall consist of one male and one female competitor who are free to choose who is the patient and who is the rescuer.
- Upon application to the Sectional Referee competitors may make up composite teams from different clubs and may be awarded placings (but not prizes or placing points for their clubs).
