Next Intake for Surf Rescue 30 Commences early January 2013

All Trainees are required **What do I Need?**

- Be a minimum of 16 years of age
- Financial club member and Bronze Medallion proficient
- Hold an ARTC, Apply Senior First Aid and Spinal Management awards

What is involved?

- Attend a two hour briefing and orientation session where all new trainee members will be issued with an online roster username and password and a Training Record Book.
- All trainee members will then roster as a trainee for January to April patrols and be required to attain 25 hours of trainee patrols before being eligible to sit for the Crewperson's Award.
- During these patrols "trainees" will be trained according to the record of training book. All training will be entered into the book and signed off by the Skipper.
- During patrols trainees will undertake a minimum of 1 hour of training whilst on that patrol to ensure they are ready for the next step in the training process.
- Once a trainee achieves 25 patrol hours, they will be scheduled for the "next available" one day of scenarios and practical training prior to their exam. A minimum of 4 trainees are required before this day is scheduled
