## **Dear Clubs**

Further to queries the Branch Office has been receiving from Clubs in processing the above Skills Maintenance this season in Surfguard, please see below the SLSNSW recommended procedure:

## Processing Advanced Resuscitation Techniques (ARTC) and ART [AID] skills maintenance

Following the updating of the Health Training Package in 2014, there are now two awards on SurfGuard for Advanced Resuscitation (as below).

- Advanced Resuscitation Techniques Certificate (ARTC)
- Advanced Resuscitation Techniques [AID]

Some members will hold one and some will hold both. Members who hold the [AID] award have upgraded to or been issued with the most current unit of competency (HLTAID007).

To ensure that ART proficiencies are correctly processed this season, please follow the below process:

Following the skills maintenance session:

- 1. Create a New Assessment Request for 'Advanced Resuscitation Techniques [AID]' as a 'Bulk Proficiency'.
- 2. From the list of members who have completed the ART skills maintenance (as recorded on a Proficiency Card), select (and move to the right side box) the members whose names appear in the 'Candidates: Available:' box, plus tick these names off on the Proficiency Card as you go.
- 3. Once you have processed these, create another New Assessment Request for the award 'Advanced Resuscitation Techniques Certificate' as a 'Bulk Proficiency'.
- 4. Select only the remaining members from the Proficiency Card and process as normal

Trust this this procedure clarifies any processing queries.
