Over the last 2 seasons Sydney Branch Scrutineers have been extremely busy in scrutineering over 1500 pieces of surf craft in the transfer process from 'red and white' scrutineering stickers to the current 'black and white' stickers.

In the past NSW Surf Life Saving has also provided a paid Scrutineering service at the State Championships.

All competitors are to be reminded for the 2016 NSW State Championships including Age, Masters and Open there will be **no Scrutineering Service** available to competitors. Scrutineering will only involve random safety checks on all surf craft.

As a result it is imperative for all clubs and competitors to ensure their surf craft has been scrutineered prior to attending the NSW State Championships.

To assist in this situation Sydney Branch will be providing further scrutineering services at the following surf carnivals prior to the 2016 State Championships:

1. Ohana Carnival - Elouera 30 January 2016
2. Coogee Open Carnival - Coogee 6 February 2016
3. Branch Open Championships - Maroubra 13 February 2016
4. Branch Age Championships - Maroubra 14 February 2016.

***Please remember the current 'scrutineering stickers' are black and white. If your surf craft has been scrutineered over the past 2 years and it has a black and white sticker attached - it does not need to be scrutineered again.***
