<b>Subject:</b>	<b>Competition &amp; Patrol Hours (SLSA Policy 5.04)</b>

A general reminder to Clubs and Members that the Patrol Hour requirements for competition must be completed in line with SLSA Policy 5.04 (attached for reference).

Where a member is employed and rostered as a paid Lifeguard they cannot sign on to the voluntary patrol in order to gain hours towards competition.

Bonus hours cannot be offered as an incentive to members, **one hour on patrol = one hour.**

Patrol Log audits are routinely carried out by Branch, State and SLSA; should a Club or Member be found to have breached this policy then the appropriate action will be taken.

Please ensure that all members are familiar with SLSA Policy 5.04
