Dear Clubs

Following on from the memo sent to clubs on the 4<sup>th</sup> August, Branch has been made aware that the changes planned by the SLSNSW to the Sydney Branch Radio Network are not yet complete and operational, and on the current timeline, we do not anticipate that they will be complete in time for Gear Inspection on 2<sup>nd</sup> September.

As we understand the clubs have need of their radios prior to the commencement of patrols for Season 2017/2018, the decision has been made to return radios to clubs without reprogramming.

All Club Radios will be available for collection at the Preseason Lifesaving and Education Meeting this Saturday 26<sup>th</sup> August at Maroubra SLSC if clubs do not wish to collect their radios from Branch office before Friday.

Radios that were noted at Branch Office as requiring servicing have been sent to Karera by Branch Office. We will advise when delivery of the serviced radios are received back from Karera at Branch Office (this applies to Tamarama 1 radio, Clovelly 7 radios, Bronte 3 radios, Garie 3 radios, South Maroubra 4 radios).

Radios will still be operational as per last season and we will continue to monitor the progress of the upgrades to the Radio Network and endeavour to keep clubs and services informed of when changes will be effected.

We apologise for the inconvenience caused to clubs in relation to this issue.
