- The SLS Sydney JLOTY 17/18 winners will be announced at the Branch Championships, February 2018 at Maroubra. All finalists will be invited to this event with their parents /guardians.

This is a great opportunity to put your best young lifesavers forward for consideration by the Junior Development Committee Executive.

As outlined in the State Circular the candidates need to cover off on the following areas:

- Contribution to Surf Life Saving
- Demonstration of leadership roles in club activities
- Contribution made to the club
- Awards received in Surf Life Saving and the community
- Involvement in community events outside of Surf Life Saving



- Awareness of club events and current affairs
- Initiative applied to cub and community activities
- Promotion of Surf Life Saving to the community
- Attendance record at club activities
- Encouragement of new members
- Demonstration of surf lifesaving knowledge and skills

The 2 Branch winners for 17-18 will then go to SLSNSW for inclusion in the State Development Camp in April 2018.

We wish each cub well in the selection of their JLOTY nominees and very much look forward to our finalists interviews next year in January.
