rules

Competition shall be conducted as per current SLSA Surf Sports Manual except where detailed here.

ALL COMPETITORS

- Must have their age group clearly marked on their upper left arm
- Are to be registered prior to competing
- All competitors and handlers must wear pink fluorescent singlets as outer layer when entering the water.

Most events will be conducted in "block" (i.e. heats where required). Finals intermixed (male & female) for adequate rest, at Carnival Referee discretion. If numbers, conditions and time allows, certain selected events may have extra rounds or races added, to provide more racing & encourage participation. These decisions are to be made on the day at the Carnival Referee's discretion.

Courses for all events, may vary at the discretion of the Carnival Referee in consultation with the Competition Committee. The aim is to have relatively short course racing (conditions allowing).

Factoring in safety, field sizes may exceed recommended numbers outlined in the current SLSA Surf Sports Manual at the discretion of the Carnival Referee to allow for the efficient completion of the carnival program.

ROUNDS - single gender event per age group

If time allows and at the water referee's discretion, extra board races (or extra rounds of board races), can be added. This will be time, conditions & numbers dependent and will be the referee's call on the day.

ALL AGE BOARD RELAY (single or mixed gender event – 3 person teams) Numbers dependent – run at Water Referee's discretion.

Mixed teams are allowed. Each team member paddles one leg each

Each team should consist of: 1 x U14 or 15 1 x U19 and 1 x Open

The event must start with the U14/15 competitors the order of the following two competitors is at discretion of the team.

Rules for age groups of competitors will be flexible on the day – to encourage teams & participation.

beach relay

4 person relay event with each team member running one leg each. Combined gender event 4 person team

Each team should consist of: 1 x U14 1 x U15 1 x U19 1 x Open

Rules for age groups of competitors will be flexible on the day – to encourage teams & participation.

cameron taplin relays

MIXED GENDER teams are allowed – in both Cameron & Taplin relays to create more teams & gives more competitors extra racing.

CAMERON

Every team MUST have a SWIMMER & BOARD paddler as a minimum.

The order of the event legs will be swim, run, board, run.

2 person team will have both SWIMMER & BOARD paddler do the RUN legs (Cameron)

3 person team will have 1 RUNNER, to tag both the SWIMMER & BOARD paddler. (Cameron)

4 person team will have 2 RUNNERS - 1 to tag the SWIMMER, the OTHER to TAG BOARD paddler.

TAPLIN

Must be a 3 person team (1 for each leg) as per normal program – 1 swimmer, 1 board paddler, 1 ski paddler

carnival program

Order of scheduled events listed below, is at the Carnival Referee & Competition Committee's discretion on the day, allowings for conditions & other factors.

Entry numbers will determine if ALL events listed are either run, or run in the scheduled order.; or combined with other events – to allow for maximum participation. North Cronulla SLSC aim for the carnival is to encourage participation & enjoyment. Therefore a large degree of flexibility will be shown for events – especially TEAM events.

Composite or mixed gender teams will be allowed & encouraged, and where possible & time dependent, extra rounds or extra racing may be accommodated.
