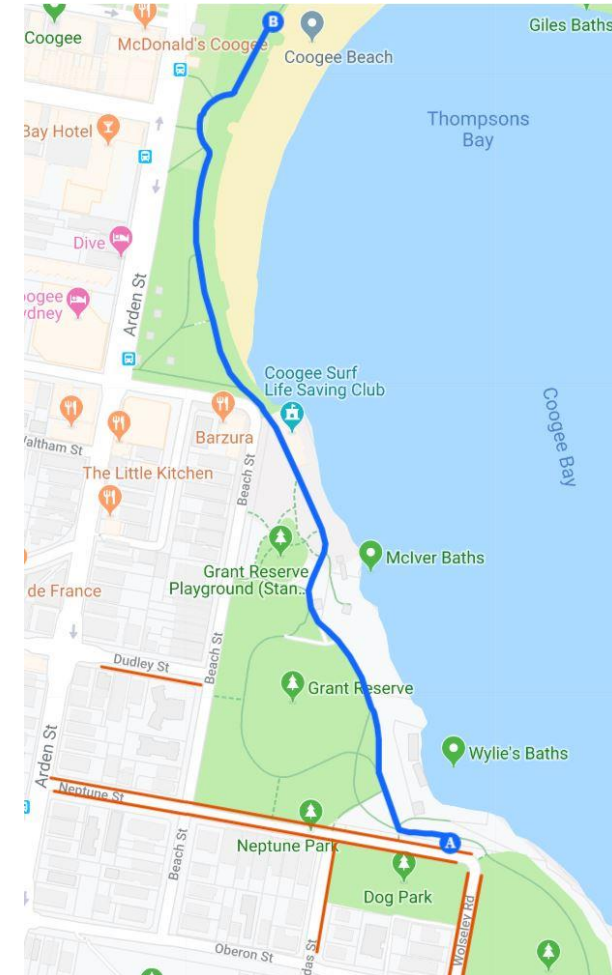
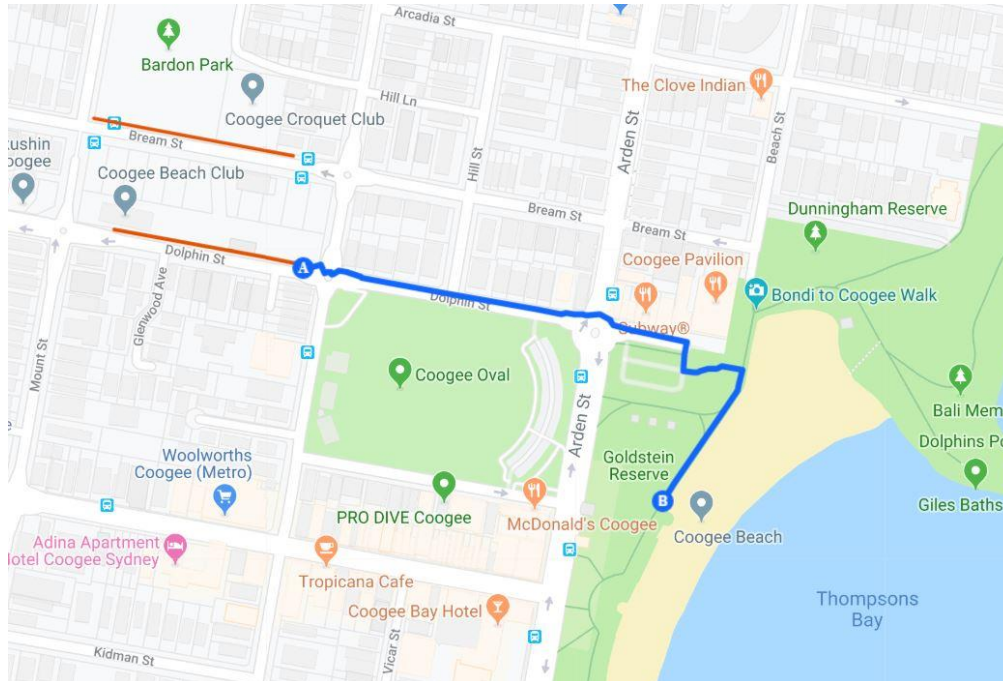
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These maps indicate (in orange) some areas of untimed street parking close to Coogee Beach. Please note the activities will be taking place at the north end of the beach, which would represent:
