Subject	Garie SLSC Patrol Assistance 2019/20

Dear Clubs,

As part of Surf Life Saving Sydney's continued commitment to support Garie Surf Life Saving Club, all clubs this coming season will again be called upon to assist by providing Lifesaving Patrols on Saturday's and Public Holiday's at Garie Beach.

Background:

Garie Surf Life Saving Club has faced several major issues over the past few seasons. Garie SLSC has committed to continuing lifesaving patrols at Garie Beach, but the current membership numbers, and previous season's workload has made it unsustainable for the Garie club to fulfil its current Lifesaving Service Agreement without support from the other clubs in the Branch. Surf Life Saving Sydney has been working in conjunction with Garie SLSC & SLSNSW and through this process has identified that for the Upcoming Season, Garie SLSC will only be able to provide Lifesaving Patrols on Sunday's.

Given the nature of Garie Beach as a tourist hotspot, it is critical that the full current Lifesaving Service Agreement is maintained to maintain Garie SLSC's proud record of "No Lives Lost" between the flags.

Execution:

There are a total of 39 Saturday & Public Holiday Patrol Days that need to be filled at Garie SLSC as a result of this. Clubs within Surf Life Saving Sydney will be allocated a number of patrols in accordance with the number of active members that club has.

The allocation for clubs is as follows:

Nomination of Dates:

Clubs are now kindly asked to approach their membership for support to provide these patrols during this difficult time. We are also asking that Club Captains review their current published or draft patrol rosters and nominate dates which they would like to fill based on the allocation of patrols above (including entire weekend patrols and mixed club patrols if desired).

Considerations for these nominations will close at COB Friday 19 July 2019. Proposed dates should be sent direct to the SLSS Lifesaving Manager via email $\frac{1}{2}$

Following the closure of this consideration period, the SLSS Lifesaving Manager will assign clubs to dates. Clubs are kindly asked to assist in this process by providing the members to fill their patrol allocation.

Administration:

- Management of Surf Life Saving Sydney patrols at Garie Beach will be the responsibility of the SLSS Lifesaving Manager, in conjunction with the Garie Club Captain, & the Club Captains of the SLSS Clubs patrolling at Garie.
- Clubs that are unable to fulfil their allocated patrol at Garie are kindly asked to notify the SLSS Lifesaving Manager & Garie Club Captain AT LEAST 2 weeks prior to the rostered patrol date. It is requested that if a club is unable to attend, they find another club who is able to attend and assist in their stead.
- Garie SLSC is to provide patrol equipment for the Clubs patrolling at Garie SLSC. This
 equipment is to be maintained at all times by Garie SLSC & must be compliant with
 SLSNSW Standard Operating Procedures.
- Patrols at Garie SLSC are to be made up in accordance with the current Lifesaving Service Agreement, however SLS Sydney recommends that a minimum of 5 patrolling members are on patrol at Garie SLSC at any one time.
