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Subject	Powercraft Operation Safety Reminder

As the Christmas and New Year period has quickly passed and clubs are returning to normal training operations, it serves as a timely reminder to reinforce the importance of Powercraft Safety when operating and training in IRB's and RWC's.

The following must be adhered to whilst operating ANY Powercraft within Surf Life Saving Sydney.

- All Powercraft operators must carry at least one (1) portable radio with them and have access to Channel 3.
- All Powercraft operators must sign on and off with SurfCom for any training exercise.
- All Powercraft operators must be off the water and on the beach by SurfCom closure (Summer - 7pm & Winter - 5pm).
- All Powercraft training must have a suitable and dedicated Water Safety team (or patrol) available to assist if required before training commences.

Should any of the above be not adhered to, a review of the operators suitability to conduct Powercraft operations may be conducted.
