## Who needs to attend RWC Proficiency?

- Those operators who completed <u>less than 20 hours</u> of RWC patrols during season 18-19 are required to attend the RWC proficiency. (refer to <u>Branch Circular 33</u> to check your RWC patrol hours from last season)
- The proficiency will include demonstrated craft knowledge as well as basic riding skill and a single conscious patient pick up. Failure to complete a proficiency will result in operators being removed from the Branch RWC group for the season.

# What to bring to Proficiency?

Wetsuit, Towel, Sunscreen, Bottle of water, Warm change of clothing etc

#### Who is NOT required to attend RWC Proficiency?

• Those operators who completed 20 + hours of RWC patrols during season 18-19, do not need to undertake a RWC proficiency this season. Eligibility of this requirement is as per hours published in <u>Branch Circular 33</u>.
