- **RWC Operators Pre Season Meeting** - Saturday 21 September 2019 3pm @ Branch Office, 16 Murra Murra Place Little Bay. Attendance by all operators is required at this meeting.

Who needs to attend RWC Proficiency?

- Those operators who completed less than 20 hours of RWC patrols during season 18-19 are required to attend the RWC proficiency. (refer to [Branch Circular 33](#) to check your RWC patrol hours from last season)
- The proficiency will include demonstrated craft knowledge as well as basic riding skill and a single conscious patient pick up. Failure to complete a proficiency will result in operators being removed from the Branch RWC group for the season.

What to bring to Proficiency?

Wetsuit, Towel, Sunscreen, Bottle of water, Warm change of clothing etc

Who is NOT required to attend RWC Proficiency?

- Those operators who completed 20 + hours of RWC patrols during season 18-19, do not need to undertake a RWC proficiency this season. Eligibility of this requirement is as per hours published in [Branch Circular 33](#).
