06:30	Two Person R&R: U10/11, U12/13, U14/15	06:45	07:00	<ul> <li>a) All officials, coaches, and competitors must enter the competition area through the ENTRY point on the southern end where they must sign in on their first entry in using the QR code.</li> <li>b) Reporting/marshalling area southern end of competition area on the beach side of the marshalling pegs</li> <li>c) Maximum of one coach/handler per team in the marshalling area at any time.</li> </ul>
07:30	Five Person R&R: U12-U14, U14/U15, U17, Opens	07:45	08:00	<ul> <li>d) No parents/spectators allowed in the marshalling/competition area.</li> <li>e) No Competitors, only officials allowed in the recording tent, but social distancing must be maintained.</li> <li>f) Results to be announced over the PA system and score cards to be made available electronically.</li> <li>g) No sharing of stationery – judges to be issued with their own clipboards and pencils.</li> <li>h) Officials to keep the required distance from each other and competitors.</li> </ul>
08:30	March Past	08:45	09:00	<ul> <li>i) Parents, spectators, coaches, etc. to maintain social distancing outside of competition area.</li> <li>j) All teams must leave the competition area with their reels and tubes immediately at the conclusion of their individual heats/events via the EXIT point as instructed by officials</li> <li>k) All teams must sanitize their shared reels between heats/events.</li> <li>l) All teams must re-enter the competition area via the ENTRY point for successive heats/events.</li> </ul>



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- i. Each of the attending clubs may erect one tent set behind the competition area (on the beach side of the bunting) subject to space being available for ATV access to and from the ramp in front of the Maroubra surf club, and along the beach, parallel to the promenade.
- ii. Social distancing must be maintained outside the competition area by parents, spectators, coaches, and competitors.
- iii. Please arrive in good time so your coaches/handlers can report your presence using the using the QR code.
- iv. Unfortunately, due to COVID restrictions there will be no BBQ or bar service at the Maroubra surf club. However, Maroubra SLSC's generous supporters, the Maroubra Seals Sports and Community Club will be open for business across the road, and we would love to have you join us for refreshments at reasonable prices and under COVID safe conditions
