Entries

- Entries are only open to members of the Bate Bay Clubs and will be limited in number as follows.
 - 8 competitors per club, per age, per gender, for water events
 - 6 competitors per club, per age, per gender, for beach events
- The organising club will manage the registration process. Intending competitors who have not done so already need to make urgent contact with their respective squad leader
- Proficiencies will be checked through Surfguard and completion certificates from clubs to ensure adherence to safety protocols.

Cost

\$30 per competitor, covering the 2 rounds of competition.

Prizes

Prizes for Top 3 in each age group Water & Beach.

COVID Safety

- A QR code check-in will be required on entry
 - Only competitors, officials, water safety, 1 x age manager per club will be allowed entry to the area. No parents in the area.
- Competitors will not be allowed to come and go from the area and will remain in the area for the duration of the carnival (turn up, compete, leave)
- COVID Marshalls will be monitoring entry points.

Officials and Water Safety personnel ratios

- As per SLISA requirements, we are aiming for between 10-20 water safety per water area.
- Officials as per required positions for beach and water.

COVID Management

Each Beach will host a separate "Community Sporting Activity" (CSA) per the NSW Public Health Guidelines.

Total participants, including Nippers, parents, officials and water safety, will not exceed 500 per CSA.

Bunting will be used to segregate each CSA from the public, with the exception of Surfing (which is held fully within the ocean) and Participant records will be maintained for each CSA.

A COVID-19 Safety Plan will be prepared for the Series in accordance with the prevailing NSW Public Health Guidelines.

The CSAs will be run in accordance with the Series COVID Plan.

Carnival Entry

Water - Maximum 32 entries per category for water events (age group / gender). Total = 128 maximum competitors in each area

Carnival Logistics

Carnivals will be completed and beach cleared by 10.30am each Saturday

Each club to setup and pack down their own beach

U9 & U10 Board Relays only if time permits

Locations for each age group may change based on surf conditions on the day

One water area per beach, IRB and Water safety ratios as per requirements by SLSA.

Overall Series Point Score

Series Points are allocated to the Swim, Board and Ironperson for Overall Series Water Champion

Series points are allocated to Flags and Sprints for Overall Beach Champion

Point Score for events:

1st place = 10 points

2nd place = 8 points

3rd place = 7 points

4th place = 6 points

5th place = 5 points

6th place = 4 points
