<b>Subject</b>	<b>Updating HLTAID001 for Bronze/SRC Trainers and Assessors</b>

Hello

The adoption of the new curriculum for the Surf Rescue Certificate and Bronze Medallion has introduced additional requirements for our Trainers, Assessors and Facilitators (TAFs).

**All TAFs for SRC and Bronze must hold a current Provide CPR (HLTAID001) award.** This is usually obtained with a Provide First Aid course, but only has a 12 month validity. Without this award, TAFs cannot be placed on an Assessment Request for SRC or Bronze, so **cannot train or assess**. Although we do a CPR component during the annual Skills Maintenance, this is unfortunately not sufficient to update the HLTAID001 award.

Sydney Branch is asking for your **assistance with updating this award** for TAFs in your club.

There is a course available from SLSNSW that awards HLTAID001, which is called the Resuscitation Certificate [AID], which you may already run in your club for junior members.

It is not expected that TAFs will require any training for this course and the assessment can be run by any Assessor Bronze Medallion with current HLTAID003 (Provide First Aid) and HLTAID001. The assessment has the following elements :

- 14 multiple choice theory questions
- 2 minutes of CPR on adult manikin with use of AED
- 2 minutes of CPR on infant manikin
- Participate in one CPR scenario with verbal or written report

The **total time for assessment** should be **less than 45 minutes**, dependent on numbers of candidates, resources and assessors.

The Learner Guide and Assessment Guide for the course can be found in the Members Area – Document Library by selecting Surf Life Saving NSW as the Organisation and searching for “Resuscitation Certificate”.
