Hi Team,

Firstly, a big thankyou to all Clubs who have forwarded the names of their GI Team to me for SLSNSW to issue letters of exemption to be able to prepare gear for Gear Inspection Saturday 4<sup>th</sup> September.

Further to our Pre Gear Inspection meeting held 14/8, we provide the following information in relation to the 3 questions raised for clarification :

1. **Tourniquets** - 1 in the FA room and 1 in the FA kit is sufficient.
2. **Pulse Oximeter** - It is perfectly fine to wait until the CLEG oximeter is delivered and then sign off on it. No need to buy one especially for GI
3. **Spare Pads for clubs with Multiple (5 or so) Defibs.** A sensible provision of spare Defib pads should be in place to service the club / service's defib numbers. According to SLSNSW there is not a requirement for 5 sets for 5 defibs. 2 spare sets will suffice
