Subject	HLTAID Upgrade Sessions for ARTC TAFs - Offer to Trainers

As some of you are aware, there is a new version (5) of the Advanced Resuscitation Techniques course being released shortly which incorporates the HLTAID015 award (in place of HLTAID007). In order to deliver the new course in the near future, current ARTC TAFs will need to obtain the following Units of Competency :

- HLTAID015 Provide Advanced Resuscitation & Oxygen Therapy
- HLTAID011 Provide First Aid •

We have organised some accelerated upgrade sessions with the SLSNSW Academy. These have been offered to current Facilitators and Assessors, and there are some additional places which can now be offered to ARTC Trainers. We are asking Club CTOs to nominate one or two ARTC Trainers for consideration – there are roughly 20 places currently available.

These sessions will take approximately four hours and will award the above Units of Competency as well as HLTAID009 (Provide CPR) and HLTAID010 (Provide Basic Emergency Life Support).

Location is the Surf Lifesaving Sydney Branch office in Little Bay and the following sessions are available :

Saturday 31 July 1:00pm to 5:00pm Sunday 1 August 1:00pm to 5:00pm
