# Iron Person Classic RULES AND CONDITIONS

- 1. All competitors must be financial members of a SLSA Club and must be currently proficient.
- 2. Competitors must wear club caps, costumes & high vis pink rash vests and Handlers must wear club cap & high vis pink rash vests
- 3. Order of events to be decided on the day.
- 4. The Water Safety Captain & Officials reserve the right to withdraw any competitor if their health or safety appears to be an unacceptable risk. The Water Safety decision will be final.
- 5. Competitors must not receive any outside assistance during the event.
- 6. The judge's decision will be final.
- 7. All competitors' boards must comply with the S.L.S. NSW Craft specifications.
- 8. Competitors can only compete in their own age group. They are not allowed to compete up in individual races.
- 9. Under 9 & 10 registrations will be accepted online and on the day, once the Carnival Referee & Water Safety Captain have made a decision regarding the conditions being suitable.
- 10. All payments are NON-REFUNDABLE
- 11. All presentations to be held around the James Perryman Memorial Pool, North Cronulla SLSC after the conclusion of all events.
