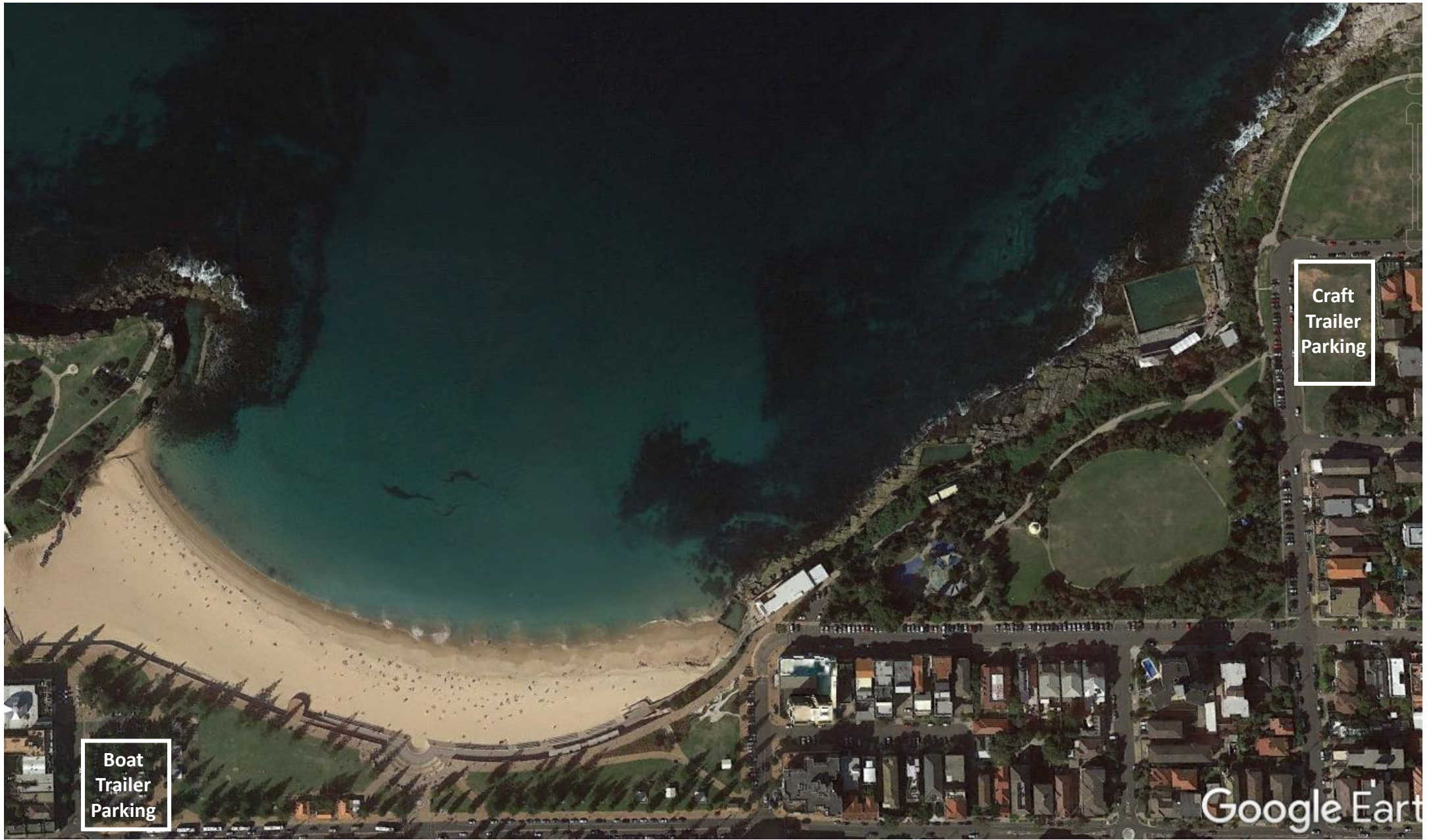




PROCESS OF BOAT UNLOADING LOOP

1. Boat to approach from Beach street north end.
2. Trailers unhooked and lined up on promenade awaiting tractor (side by side)
3. Car to move to car park ASAP with special parking permit (to be made). Car only. Trailer to be pushed via crews into car park
4. Tractors tows boat onto beach where boat is unpacked. It is encouraged at this point to remove tents before putting boats on the beach.
5. Empty trailers to be removed from beach by tractor and taken to car park for drop off loop
6. Boats to be rowed to the southern end for a 6.30am sweeps meeting and 7am report.
