Dear Clubs,

Sydney Branch is committed to working with SLSNSW to improve radio coverage across the Branch, and in our recent discussions with SLSNSW have been made aware of changes to the way the current Digital Mobile Radios are to be programmed, meaning current radios need to be updated prior to the Annual Gear Inspection on 2nd September.

As per last season, SLSNSW will cover the cost of the reprogramming and we will aim for all Sydney Radios to be completed in a single batch.

Clubs are requested to please arrange delivery of their radios to Branch office no later than 4pm Friday 11th August 2017, after which the Radios will be attended to by Karera and reprogrammed accordingly.

Clubs that do not have radios to the Branch by this date will need to arrange reprogramming with Karera themselves.

Should clubs require radios to be serviced, they are asked to kindly mark these radios clearly. Karera will need to take these radios back to their office so they can be serviced. The cost to service a radio has been fixed at \$32.50 per radio, plus parts. These radios can be dropped off to the branch at the same time as the radio's getting reprogrammed.

Club Captains and Gear Stewards are asked to kindly pass this information to the relevant radio officer in their club.
