The Aim of the carnival for water and beach is:

Is for a short, sharp, competitive and select number of events to be conducted. To provide the competitors a good "hit out" and racing leading into the Christmas break. To conduct some events in a different and more individual manner and to encourage participation in ALL TEAM Events. For everyone to enjoy themselves!

General Supplementary Carnival Rules

Competition shall be conducted as per the current edition SLSA Surf Sports Manual except where detailed in this section.

All competitors must have their age group clearly marked on their upper left

arm. All competitors are to register on the day of the carnival prior to

competing.

All competitors and handlers must wear pink fluorescent coloured singlets as their outer layer of clothing when entering the water.

Most events will be conducted in "block" (i.e. heats where required). Finals intermixed (male & female) for adequate rest. At carnival referee's discretion.

If numbers are not excessive, certain selected events would be run in a 'round robin' format – to provide more racing for those events & encourage participation. So best results from 3 rounds would provide the overall results.

Courses for all events, may vary at the discretion of the Carnival Referee in consultation with the Competition Committee.

Primarily taking into account all safety issues - field sizes for events may exceed the recommended numbers outlined in the current SLSA Surf Sports Manual at the discretion of the Carnival Referee to allow for the efficient completion of the carnival program.

Supplementary Rules:

BOARD RACES - ROUND ROBIN: (single gender event - per AGE group)

Points are awarded from 1st to 16th placing only for each event (board race).

Points (pts) awarded as follows: $1^{st} = 1$ pts, $2^{nd} = 2$ pts, $3^{rd} = 3$ pts, $4^{th} = 4$ pts, $5^{th} = 5$ pts & $6^{th} = 6$ pts....onto to $16^{th} = 16$ pts.

The final will consist of the 12 competitors with the 12 lowest combined scores from the 3 rounds of board races.

THE JOKER or WILDCARD is: the WINNER of any of the 3 board races in an AGE group and is AUTOMATICALLY in the Final.

If it happens that a board race winner IS NOT one of the 12 lowest scores for that AGE group – they are <u>still IN</u> <u>THE FINAL</u> – and the field will be increased to 13 or 14 competitors.

<u>CAMERON RELAY (mixed gender event if required – can be 2,3,4-person teams)</u>

At a minimum every team MUST have a SWIMMER & BOARD paddler.

A 2 person team – will have both SWIMMER & BOARD paddler do the RUN legs.

A 3 person team – will have 1 RUNNER, to tag both the SWIMMER & BOARD paddler.

A person team—will have 2 RUNNERS: 1 to tag the SWIMMER; the OTHER to TAG the BOARD paddler.

MIXED GENDER teams are allowed.

ALL AGE BOARD RELAY (single gender event – 4 person teams)

4 person Board relay event with each team member paddling one leg each.

Each team must consist of:

1 x U15, 1 x U12, 1 x U13 and 1 x U14.

The U15 competitor must commence the event after which the order of competitors will be Under 12, Under 13 and then Under14.

Rules for age groups of competitors will be flexible on the day – to encourage teams & participation.

ALL AGE BEACH RELAY (combined gender event 4 person team)

4 person relay event with each team member running one leg each. Each team must consist of at least:

1 x U12, 1 x U13, 1 x U14, 1 x U15.

Rules for age groups of competitors will be flexible on the day – to encourage teams & participation.

The order of the legs of the <u>Cameron relay event</u> will be <u>swim, run, board, run.</u>

To encourage participation & more events for ALL competitors – Cameron teams can be 2-person; 3-person or 4-person. They can also be mixed gender if that creates more teams & gives more competitors extra racing.

Order of scheduled events listed below, is at the carnival referee & competition committee's discretion on the day. This allows for conditions & other factors.

Entry numbers will determine if ALL events listed are either run, or run in the scheduled order.

North Cronulla SLSC for this carnival really wants to encourage participation & enjoyment. Therefore a large degree of flexibility will be shown for events – especially TEAM events. As stated above composite teams will be allowed & encouraged to compete on the day. Where possible & time dependent, 'round robin' events for the Board races or extra racing could well be accommodated in these age groups.
