This event is conducted as part of the SLS Sydney Branch Championships and will be conducted on **Friday 8 February 2019 PM (Resus & Theory Components) and Saturday 9 February 2019** during the Branch Open & Masters Championships at Maroubra Beach.

Location & Entries

The Lifesaving Championship events will be held at the Branch Open and Master Championships at Maroubra Beach with the lifesaving events commencing at 8am on the Saturday morning.

The theory / resuscitation components will be conducted at Maroubra Surf Club on the Friday night 8 February commencing at 6.00 pm.

- Entries are now open via Carnival Manager.
- Sydney Branch Lifesaving Championships @ Maroubra is the name of the event.
- Entries close online Friday 1st February 2019 11pm.
- Entry fee is \$20 + GST per competitor. Club Payment for entries is due before Branch Championships.

SLSS reserves the right to cancel an event in the case where fewer than 4 entries are received.

Competitors are permitted to compete in one (1) age group only

** Each Club may enter maximum 2 Teams in the Patrol Competition.

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Clubs may enter as many individuals in the Champion Lifesaver events.

All events will be run in accordance with the current 35th Edition Surf Sports Manual and the 34th (revised July 2016) Edition Public Safety and Aquatic Rescue Manual. A copy of Section 3 of the Surf Sports Manual - Lifesaving Events can be found in Library/Sport areas of SLSA Members Area.

All Clubs should familiarise themselves in the conduct of these events. Clubs must be attired correctly as per the surf sports manual.

EQUIPMENT

- Competitors / Clubs will bring their own rescue boards, tubes, first aid kits, air bag, swim fins, resus masks and other equipment as required (refer to surf sports manual).
- Competitors/Clubs to provide Manikins, plastic bags, cleaning solution and masks and pen.

PRIZES

- Medals will be presented to First, Second & Third place getters
- Points from event placings go towards the competition point score for the Open Branch Championships

REPORT

Teams and Individuals are to report to the Maroubra Surf Clubhouse (upstairs) for marshalling :

- Friday 8 February 2019 6pm for 6.30 pm start
- Saturday 9 February 2019 7.30 am for 8am start

Teams and individuals are reminded that as part of some of the events a 'competitor lock down' will be required as part of competition as per the manual. During this time you may NOT be permitted to compete in other events being held at the Branch Championships. We will however ensure that the 'lock down' time is as short as possible.
