Subject	RWC Skills Maintenance Dates Season 2018-2019 – 2 nd round of dates

Dear RWC Operators

Great to see the turn out to the RWC proficiency dates already conducted. To assist with those operators who still need to complete the proficiency, we have scheduled 2 more dates :

- **Saturday 6 October 2018 10.00 am @ Lugano Facilitator : Ryan Rosenbaum**
- **Saturday 20 October 2018 9am @ South Maroubra (meet at the Surf Club's IRB shed carpark side of clubhouse) Facilitator : John Restuccia**

Who is NOT required to attend one of these RWC Proficiency dates?

- Those who have already attended and successfully completed RWC proficiency on one of the previous 2 dates.
- Those operators who completed 20 + hours of RWC patrols during season 17-18, do not need to undertake a RWC proficiency this season. Eligibility of this requirement is as per hours published in Branch Circular 32/17-18 and names listed in previous memo sent 1/8/18 to all operators.
- RWC operators who completed their RWC award assessment on 29/7/2018 are not required to attend a RWC proficiency this season.

Who is to attend one of these RWC Proficiency dates?

- Those operators who completed less than 20 hours of RWC patrols during season 17-18 are required to attend one of the RWC proficiency dates (refer to previous memo sent dated 1/8/18)

The proficiency will include demonstrated craft knowledge as well as basic riding skill and a single conscious patient pick up. Failure to complete a proficiency will result in operators being removed from the Branch RWC group for the season.

What to bring to Proficiency?

Wetsuit, Towel, Sunscreen, Bottle of water, Warm change of clothing etc
