Dear All,

All competitors are to be reminded for the 2019 NSW State Championships including Age, Masters and Open there will be **no Scrutineering Service** available to competitors. Scrutineering will only involve checks on all surf craft.

As a result, it is imperative for all clubs and competitors to ensure their surf craft has been scrutineered prior to attending the NSW State Championships.

As published at the beginning of the 2018/19 season, Sydney Branch will be providing scrutineering services at the following surf carnivals prior to the 2018 State Championships.

1. Waverley Shield - 18<sup>th</sup> November 2018 @ North Bondi
2. Wanda Carnival – 19<sup>th</sup> January 2019
3. Branch Age Championships – 10<sup>th</sup> February 2019 @ Maroubra
4. Branch Open Championships -9<sup>th</sup> February 2019 @ Maroubra

As a general rule, scrutineering will commence at approximately 7.30am at each of the above carnivals and will only operate while there is a demand. It is advisable that if you do require your surf craft to be scrutineered that you present your craft to the scrutineers as close to 7.30am as possible.

***Please remember the current 'scrutineering stickers' are black and white. If your surf craft has been scrutineered over the past few years and it has a black and white sticker attached – it does not need to be scrutineered again.***
