Purpose	To provide policy, procedure and best practice for Rescue
	Water Craft (RWC) Operations.
Policy	Surf Life Saving NSW (SLSNSW) requires all RWC Operators to adhere to the established policies, procedures and guidelines to ensure safe and effective practices relating to RWC operations.
RWC Service Objective	To provide operational support to existing patrols and patrolling/emergency response capacity to non-patrolled areas.
Scope of Operation Patrol Season / Patrol Days / Patrol Times	The minimum patrol season/hours for an RWC service shall be as agreed in the Lifesaving Service Agreement between SLSS and SLSNSW.
	RWC's shall undertake rostered patrols on Saturdays, Sundays and Public Holidays within the patrol season.
Scope of Operation After Hours / Emergency Callouts	RWC's shall have the capacity to respond to after- hours/out-of-season emergencies within the scope of the SLSNSW SOP's on Emergency Response Systems.
Communications	RWC's will use their allocated call signs given to them by SLSS and communicate with SurfCom as per current SLSNSW SOPs.

	Support Ski 2 – Located at Cronulla (Sutherland LGA)
	Support Ski 3 – Located at Maroubra (Randwick LGA) Support Ski 4 – Located at North Bondi (Waverley LGA)
