TITLE: UAV OPERATIONS WITHIN SYDNEY BRANCH

Purpose	To provide policy, procedure and best practice for Unmanned aerial vehicles (UAV) / Drones.
Policy	Surf Life Saving NSW (SLSNSW) requires all UAV Operators to adhere to the established policies, procedures and guidelines to ensure safe and effective practices relating to UAV operations.
UAV Service Objective	To provide operational support to existing patrols and patrolling/emergency response capacity to non-patrolled areas.
Scope of Operation Patrol Season / Patrol Days / Patrol Times	The minimum patrol season/hours for the UAV service in SLSS shall be determined by the Support Operations committee.
	UAV Operators shall undertake rostered "call out" patrols on Saturdays, Sundays and Public Holidays within the patrol season.
Scope of Operation After Hours / Emergency Callouts	UAV's shall have the capacity to respond to after- hours/out-of-season emergencies within the scope of the SLSNSW SOP's on Emergency Response Systems.
Communications	UAV operators will use their allocated call signs given to them by SLSS and will communicate with SurfCom / SLSS Duty officers or Rescue Coordinators when required.
	Sydney UAV 1 – North (Randwick / Waverley) Sydney UAV 2 – South (Batebay / RNP)
Review	The SOM and Support Operations Committee will review this SOP annually.
