TITLE: Support Ski 1 (Spare) Response Area

DATE: 14 February 2017

Scope	This SOP applies to Rescue Coordinators, Duty Officers, RWC Operators and Support Ski 1 (Spare).
Purpose	To define the response areas of Support Ski 1 (Spare).
Introduction	This SOP has been developed so that there is a clear understanding of response and training areas for Support Ski 1 (Spare).
Activation	Support Ski 1 primary role is as a training Ski for Sydney Branch. Ski 1 can be tasked by the Support Operations Manager to provide additional support to rostered Ski patrols or can be used for water safety for special events.
	When signed on for patrol, Support Ski 1 (Spare) is activated via SurfCom and Sydney Branch Rescue Coordinators during patrol hours and via Sydney Branch Rescue Coordinators after hours to incidents.
Area of Operation	Designated training areas in Randwick(LGA) and Sutherland Shire(LGA).
	The secondary response area is Diamond Bay in the Waverley (LGA) to Port Hacking Point in the Sutherland Shire (LGA).
	This will be part of the Lifesaving service Agreement (LSA) signed between the SLSS and SLNSW.
Communications	All communications should be carried out on mobile phone and normal Surf Life Saving Sydney Branch radio channels.
Review	The SOM and Support Operations Committee will review this SOP annually.
