This event is conducted as part of the SLS Sydney Branch Championships and will be conducted on Friday 7th and Saturday 8th February 2020 during the Branch Open & Masters Championships at Maroubra Beach as per the timetable detailed below. We encourage Clubs to promote these events within your membership.

Location, Entries & Timetable

- The Lifesaving Championship events will be held at Maroubra Beach.
- **Friday 7 February 2020 5.00 pm** – Beach Sprint, Tube Race, Board Race and Surf Race events will be conducted at Maroubra Beach.
- **Friday 7 February 2020 6.15 pm (approx.)** Theory Exam Paper will be conducted – with approximate finish time of 8.00 pm in the Maroubra SLSC Clubhouse
- **Saturday 8 February 2020** after the completion of the March Past all Lifesaving Championships event competitors will then complete the Resuscitation component of this competition. Meet in the Maroubra Clubhouse on the side balcony.
- Entries are now open via SEMS carnival entry system.
- Sydney Branch Lifesaving Championships @ Maroubra is the name of the event.
- Entries close online Thursday 30 January 2020 11pm.
- Entry fee is \$20 + GST per competitor. Club Payment for entries is due before Branch Championships.

SLSS reserves the right to cancel an event in the case where fewer than 4 entries are received.

Competitors are permitted to compete in one (1) age group only

** Each Club may enter maximum 2 Teams in the Patrol Competition.

Clubs may enter as many individuals in the Champion Lifesaver events.

All events will be run in accordance with the current 36th Edition Surf Sports Manual and the 34th (revised July 2016) Edition Public Safety and Aquatic Rescue Manual.

All Clubs/competitors should familiarise themselves in the conduct of these events. Clubs must be attired correctly as per the surf sports manual.

Equipment

- Competitors / Clubs will bring their own rescue boards, tubes, first aid kits, air bag, swim fins, resus masks and other equipment as required (refer to surf sports manual).
- Competitors/Clubs to provide Manikins, plastic bags, cleaning solution and masks and pen.

Prizes

- Medals will be presented to First, Second & Third place getters
- Points from event placings go towards the competition point score for the Open Branch Championships. Note : there will be no double points awarded for lifesaving events as in previous years.
