Service Awards/Certificates

These are for Officiating, Coaching, Training, Assessing, Age Managers and Facilitating Services Certificates. Refer pages 31 & 32.

They are issued for 5, 10, 15, 20, 25, 30, 35, 40, 45 & 50 years of service

SLSA Long Service Awards

SLSA has long service awards to recognise members for their sustained contribution to SLS. These long service awards are awarded for: 25, 30, 40, 50, 60, 70 & 75 years long service. Refer page 32.

Submit to: SLSNSW

Who Applies: Either member or club on members behalf

Cost: Free except for 25, 30 & 40 year service awards which attract a \$24.10 (Inc GST)

Due Date: Ongoing

National Patrol Service Awards

Available to all members of affiliated clubs in recognition of their long service to lifesaving patrols. The National Medal is issued by Government House via SLSA.

These Patrol Service Awards are for 5, 10, 15, 20, 25, 30, 25, 40, 45 & 50 years of service. Refer page 33.

Submit to: SLSA

Who Applies: Either member or club on members behalf

Cost: Free
Due Date: Ongoing

Application Process

All awards can be applied for via Surfguard (as a new assessment request), this requires a form to be completed (please see attached), which is endorsed by the Club and Branch then sent to either SLSA or State office whichever is the issuing body.

Any application for awards this way follows the same procedure as education awards. For Long Service Awards clubs can group members together for the same award on the one form. National Medal and National Patrol Service Awards should have one form per member.

Alternative: National Medal, National Patrol Service and Long Service Awards can be applied for via Members Area Forms. This can be done by the individual member, to be approved by the club, or by the club form approver. These require no excess paperwork as evidence is automatically listed and extra supporting documents can be uploaded into the system.
