- **The Tradies Trophy** will be presented for the Overall Club Point Score for all events conducted on the day. In addition, cash or cheque prizes of \$500 for 1<sup>st</sup>, \$300 for second and \$200 for 3<sup>rd</sup> will be awarded for the first three club teams. In the event of a dead heat in the point score the relevant cash prizes will be shared.

## Supplementary Rules and Notes:

- Sydney Branch Clubs **must** provide U8- U14 proficient water safety personnel with caps/rashies on a **one to 7** competitor ratio. Clubs will be advised of numbers and other administrative details following the close of entries.
- Sydney Branch Clubs **must** provide Officials on a **one to 10** competitor ratio.
- Competition shall be conducted as per the current edition SLSA Surf Sports Manual except where detailed in this section.
- The **Tradies** 2km Ski Challenge will be a down wind paddle into Wanda dependent on prevailing conditions. Details to be advised at marshalling. Water courses shall be set as short as practicable to encourage participation but also to ensure safe and fair competition.
- All competitors must have their age group clearly marked on their upper left arm.
- U8 to U15 Competitors must remain in their own age group in individual and team events.
- All events will be conducted in block (i.e. heats (where required) and finals immediately following).
- If practicable some age groups may be joined together in other individual events to assist competition conduct. When this occurs, competitors should nominate their age category and individual results will be recorded for each age group.
- The U15 Male and Female Cameron Relay teams may be 2, 3 or 4 person teams. If it is a three-person team, the team enters one member of the team to complete both the beach sprint legs of the event. If it is a two person team there is no separate runner.
- The **Tradies** All Age Beach Relays shall consist of 10 runners of any gender – one from each of the U9 to Open Age group. Teams must run in order of age from youngest to oldest.
- The **Gerard Malouf and Partners** Open Mixed Ocean M Lifesaver Relay teams shall each consist of 2 Male and 2 Female competitors. The event commences with a 500m beach run followed by swim, board and ski legs. Competitors complete one leg of the race and select their own gender order.
- The "Competitor with a Disability" events shall be open to members from U8 to U18 years. Dependent on numbers age Groups will be U12 and under and U13 to U18. Male and Female races may be conducted but not separate classifications. All competitors will be recognised for their participation with first second, third and some participation medals and prizes awarded. Clubs shall also be required to provide one to one (1:1) SLS qualified water safety for the Surf, Board and Wade Races.
- Upon application to the Sectional Referee competitors may make up composite teams from different clubs and may be awarded placings (but not prizes or placing points for their individual clubs).
- The Club point score shall be 6 points for 1<sup>st</sup> through to 1 point for 6<sup>th</sup> for all events conducted on the day. Dead heats will share the allotted placing points, viz. equal first both score 6 points and third scores 4 points and overall trophy prizes (i.e. there will be no countback to determine the overall club point score winner).



## Supplementary Rules and Notes (Continued):

- Consistent with the SLSA Application for Membership form and declaration, Wanda SLSC may take photographs for promotional and historical purposes only. Participation is acknowledgment of acceptance of the consent to SLSA for this to occur.
- The Carnival Committee reserves the right to cancel events and without refund of entry fees if any advertised events for the Carnival are conducted.

- Entries close at Surf Life Saving Sydney at 10pm, Wednesday, 22 January 2020. Wanda SLSC will then issue invoices.
- Entry fees of \$25 per individual competitor or \$55 per team for competition in both March Past and R&R events. However:
  - Should one or both competitors in the 2 Person R&R team enter events in addition to the 2 Person R&R, there is no individual competitor fee payable.
  - Should one or more competitors from the 5/6 Person R&R teams enter for events other than R&R, the additional individual competitor fee is \$14 per person.
  - Should one or more competitors from the March Past enter for events other than March Past the additional individual competitor fee is \$14 per person.
  - Late entries on the day are an additional \$15.00
- Please collect your entry receipt and competitor wrist bands at the Wanda SLSC Clubhouse from 6.30 am.

**Note: Wanda SLSC must receive all entry fees on or before the date of the Carnival for a Club to be eligible to compete.**
