- Events will run as per the attached program except if conditions dictate a change for the safety of the competing children. In this case, we ask all parents and nippers for their utmost respect and patience for the carnival organisers and officials.

- 3. Be stamped by their club coordinator to enable them to compete.







The Robbo Relay for the Gordon Wilson Memorial Trophy

There are 11 competitors in this event. There must be a minimum 5 females in a club team

Minimum of 2 females to compete in water component

Competitors must compete in their age group - no running up.

Order of Events for Robbo Relay

Events	Descriptions and Rules				
U10 Flag	The event will commence with an U10 competitor completing a BEACH FLAG COURSE, picking up the baton and returning with the baton back past the start line and passing the baton to the U9 Sprinter				
U9 Sprinter	The U9 sprinter positioned approximately 10 metres from the starting line from the beach flag event. The sprinter shall sprint 70 metres along the beach and shall then pass the baton to the U13 sprinter				
U13 Sprinter	The U13 sprinter shall then proceed over a 70 metre distance to the water's edge where the sprinter will tap the U8 wader				
U8 Wader	The U8 surf wade competitor will enter the water, into waist deep water, proceed along the oceanside of the wade course, cross the water finishing line and tap the U11 swimmer				
U11 Swimmer	The U11 swimmer who is positioned on the surf race start line will complete the SURF SWIM COURSE, return across the swim finishing line and tag the U11 sprinter				
U11 Sprinter	The U11 sprinter will then proceed along the beach and tag the U14 swimmer				
U14 Swimmer	The U14 swimmer who is positioned at the surf race starting line will complete the SURF SWIM COURSE, return across the swim finishing line and tag the YU14 sprinter				
U14 Sprinter	The U14 sprinter will then proceed along the beach and tag the U12 board paddler				
	The U12 board paddler who is positioned on the board race starting line with a board will complete the SURF BOARD COURSE, return across the surf board finishing line in an upright position and in full control the board and tag the U12 sprinter				
U12 Sprinter	The U12 sprinter shall then proceed over a 70 metre distance to the waters edge and tag the U13 board paddler				
	The U13 board paddler is positioned on the board race starting line with a board will complete the SURF BOARD COURSE, return across the surf board finishing line in an upright position and in full control of the board and will cross the finish line
