Subject	EOIs SLSS Duty Officers 2020/21 & 2021/2022 (2 season appointments)

Surf Life Saving Sydney is seeking Expressions of Interest for Duty Officer positions to be appointed in the Eastern Suburbs (Waverley/Randwick) and Sutherland/Royal National Park Operational Areas for seasons 2020/21 and season 2021/22. The appointments are for a period of two seasons.

Note: Current Duty Officers and Rescue Coordinators are required to reapply per the instructions below.

What do I need?

A successful candidate will meet the following essential criteria:

- Proficient Bronze Medallion holder (Cert II Public Safety – Aquatic Rescue)
- Proficient ARTC award holder
- Hold Silver Medallion Beach Management Award
- NSW Drivers Licence
- Capability to respond 24/7 if required
- Reside within a short distance to the nominated operation area
- Willing and able to drive Branch Duty Officer Response Vehicles and comply with relevant SOP's.
- Ability to commit to a rotating roster during the season, expected for patrol approximately 1 x full weekend every 6 weeks.

The following criteria is also highly desirable:

- Holder of a current Cert III Public Safety Aquatic Search and Rescue or Higher,
- Experience with emergency services or similar
- Support Operations Group experience eg. SurfCom, SR30, RWC Operator



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Role

The role of a Duty Officer will primarily perform rostered duty during the SLS season and on an 'on-call' basis to respond after hours to 13SURF tasking's, including post season. Duty Officers also provide advice and support to Clubs and Patrol Captains during major incidents, liaise with emergency services during major incidents, conduct debriefs after major incidents and coordinate lifesaving/rescue services at unpatrolled locations during or after hours. Suitable candidates will be required to undertake additional training and commence operations in a probationary/mentored capacity initially.

Candidates who submit an EOI will be required to attend a face to face interview with the Support Operations Manager and an appointed panel.
