The following is important LOGISTICS information in relation to the Surf Life Saving Sydney Branch SURF BOAT Championships.

TRAILERS AND PARKING

Trailer unloading

There is a designated drop off/pick zone for unloading and loading Boats, and parking trailers during the carnival period. This is designed to allow for effective management of the parking areas and traffic management of the Elouera Beach precinct.

The drop off/pick up zone is located on the **WEST side (only)** of Mitchell Road, opposite Elouera Beach walkway 16 (pictured in site map below). A marshal will be stationed at the drop off/pick up zone to assist crews in transporting Boats across the road. Crews are to utilise walkway 16 to access and leave the competition area.

Trailer Parking

Trailers are to be parked in the sectioned off grassed area at corner of Hume Road and Mitchell Road – **NORTH side only** (Pictured in site map below).

All car parking will be in the surrounding public streets. Please ensure you allow sufficient time to park and arrive in time for registration. All vehicles must be parked legally at all times.

Competition will take place within one designated area. Please refer to site map right as a guide noting exact position will be as determined by Lifeguards on the day of the carnival.

Tent Areas

There will be a marked-out area for club tents which will be designated by the Lifeguards on the morning of competition. Instructions on where to set up will be given on arrival.

BBQ

Elouera SLSC will be running a BBQ from 7am to 10am, on the concourse directly in front of the Club.

Amenities

Toilets and change room facilities are located at the southern end of Elouera SLSC. There will be no direct access provided to Elouera SLSC.

N.B. If there are circumstance that require an event attendee to enter the club they must adhere to Elouera SLSC COVID guidelines including using the CLUB QR system (distinct from the carnival QR code).

CONTINGENCY LOCATION

In the event that the surf conditions prevent the program being conducted at Elouera Beach, a decision will be made by the Safety and Competition Committee to move events to Kurnell Beach.

In the event that this decision is made, an announcement will be made to Team Managers onsite, and a notice placed on the Surf Life Saving Sydney Facebook page.

IRBs

North Cronulla and Wanda IRB crews are rostered on for duration of the carnival.

COVID SAFETY INFORMATION

It is essential that all attendees help maintain a COVID-safe environment by obeying the COVID safety directions from SLSS Staff and Event officials, and complying with the health directions of government and public health authorities issued at the time of the carnival.

COVID-safe declaration and QR entry

ALL event attendees MUST complete the COVID safe declaration on the day of the event using the QR code provided (refer registration below for further information).

This declaration will ask attendees to confirm:

 They are not experiencing any COVID-19 symptoms (If you are sick, stay away from others! Do not attend the event!)







- They have not been directed to self-isolate by an Australian Government Agency or under a Public Heath Alert / Order.
- They have not been in close contact with a known COVID-19 case or a reasonably suspected case of COVID-19 without PPE, or themselves been diagnosed with COVID-19

If event attendees are concerned about the declaration they should speak to their Club in advance or the appointed COVID Coordinator on the day of the carnival. (Refer to COVID declaration flowchart at appendix 1)

Handwashing and Hygiene

All attendees are encouraged to frequently sanitise, using alcohol-based hand sanitiser or wash their hands with soap and water, especially before and after eating. Sanitiser will be readily available at the competition defined entry and exit points and at various points within the competition area.

Physical Distancing at the Events

Attendees must be mindful to maintain social distancing keeping 1.5m from other persons, excluding field of play

Water Stations

All attendees are encouraged to bring their own drink bottle with them to the event. Within the competition area will be a number of water stations where it will be possible to refill bottles.

REGISTRATION & BRIEFINGS

COVID Marshalls

All club pre-registered COVID Marshalls are to report to Elouera SLSC **by 6:30am** wearing a Club COVID vest. Once they have completed the QR entry they will be given a wristband. The COVID Coordinator will then brief the COVID Marshalls and assign them the registration list and wristbands for their Club.

N.B. ONLY pre-registered attendees will be given wristbands to access the competition area.

Officials

On arrival all appointed Officials are to register at the <u>Officials registration desk (located at Elouera</u> <u>SLSC) by 7:00am</u>, wearing their official's shirts (tea/coffee will be available at registration). Once the QR entry is completed a wristband will be issued.

After registering all Officials should report directly to the competition area **<u>by 7.15am</u>** for the carnival briefing.







Competitors and Team Managers/Coaches

Club registration opens at 6:45am and closes at 7:30am. On arrival all Competitors and Team Managers/Coaches are to proceed to the competition registration area (located opposite walkway 16 at the entry to the competition area) and find their Club COVID Marshall.

The event QR code will be available around the area entrance, and a copy with COVID Marshalls, and is attached here at the end of the document. Once completed on the day the COVID Marshall will issue a wristband for entry into the competition area.

N.B. Spectators are expected to remain outside the competition area.

EVENT CONCLUSION

Please note the event has a strict end time of 12pm. Under the event COVID Safety plan a key component and one on which we seek cooperation is that competitors adopt the mantra: "Turn up, compete, leave".




All event participants MUST complete the online attendee declaration form
