Expressions of interest are now being sought from experienced members who are interested and eligible in joining the SOG RWC (Support Ski) team for our next intake of Trainees. RWC operators provide patrols along the coast including within Botany Bay as well as supporting club patrols. Because of the nature of the service, applicants will need to demonstrate a high level of lifesaving skills, surf awareness, experience and dedication. Applicants need to be aware that acceptance into training requires a commitment to complete the training program and assessment and that the applicant is prepared to undertake patrols on the RWC for SLSS. It is anticipated that you will be required to complete at least 20 hours of patrol per season as an RWC operators. Patrols consist of self roster with half day patrols, or the option of full day. These patrols are in addition to your club patrol obligations.

### **Award Pre requisites include**

- SLSA Bronze Medallion/Cert II – proficient
- First Aid Award Certificate – current
- SLSA Advanced Resuscitation Techniques (AID) Certificate – proficient
- SLSA Silver Medallion Beach Management Award
- SLSA Silver Medallion IRB Driver Award
- Motor vehicle license and the ability to tow the RWC trailer
- Three (3) years active SLS experience

**All pre requisites will be required to be met for consideration of acceptance.** Limited spots available for this training course.

#### ***Applications must include :***

1. *Award transcript from Surfguard of your awards*
2. *Letter of support from Club Captain or IRB Captain which must indicate a minimum 3 years of IRB driving and experience in all types of surf conditions.*
3. *Letter of support from your Club President that the member is suitable for single unit patrols and meets all the SLSNSW RWC prerequisites.*

The selection process includes panel comprising SLSS Director of Lifesaving and Education, Support Operations Manager and RWC Coordinator.

All applicants will be advised in writing from Branch office is successful or otherwise.

### Course / Training Duration

Successful applicants will be required to attend evening and weekend training sessions and pass a theory and practical final assessment for the RWC Operator award.

It is intended that this next intake of trainees will commence training on Thursday 29 July 2021 from service location Support Ski 2 at Lugano Ave, Burraner Bay, for those accepted into the course.

Course duration is approximately 8-10 weeks.
