- **Sunday 6 February 2022** – Theory Exam Paper, Resus, Beach Sprint, Tube Race, Board Race and Surf Race events will be conducted at Maroubra
- Entries are now open via SEMS carnival entry system.
- **SYD Branch Lifesaving Championships 2022** is the name of the event in SEMS
- Entries close **Wednesday 26 January 2022 Midnight**
- Entry fee is \$20 + GST per competitor.
- SLSS reserves the right to cancel an event in the case where fewer than 4 entries are received.

Competitors are permitted to compete in one (1) age group only

** Each Club may enter maximum 2 Teams in the Patrol Competition.

Clubs may enter as many individuals in the Champion Lifesaver events.

No competitor is able to compete up an age group in Champion Lifesaver

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All events will be run in accordance with the current 37th Edition Surf Sports Manual and the 35th Edition Public Safety and Aquatic Rescue Training Manual.

All Clubs/competitors should familiarise themselves in the conduct of these events. Clubs must be attired correctly as per the surf sports manual.

Equipment

- Competitors / Clubs will bring their own rescue boards, tubes, first aid kits, air bag, swim fins, resus masks and other equipment as required (refer to surf sports manual).
- Competitors/Clubs to provide Manikins, plastic bags, cleaning solution and masks and pen.

Prizes

- Medals will be presented to First, Second & Third placegetters
- Points from event placings go towards the competition point score for the Open Branch Championships. Note : there will be no double points awarded for lifesaving events as in previous years.

Report

Competitors are to report to the Maroubra Clubhouse (upstairs) **7.30 for marshalling with an anticipated commencement of 8.00 am** with the theory paper and resuscitation components of the competition on Sunday 6 February 2022. The order of events for the 'on the beach' will fit in with the normal carnival program in the relevant areas and will be advised on the day to Lifesaving Championship competitors by the sectional referee.
