


## 2022 & 2023 BRANCH CHAMPIONSHIPS





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### **BACKGROUND**

The Surf Life Saving Sydney (SLSS) Branch Championships is an annual event that invites all Sydney Branch Clubs to come together and showcase their lifesaving and surf sports skills.

The event is traditionally held across two days in early February each year and features a full suite of contests for U9 to Masters, as well as Surf Boats, Lifesaving and inclusive contests.

With over 2,000 competitors, the event is the biggest feature in the Sydney Branch Surf Sports calendar, offering an excellent opportunity to promote your Club and local community.





## **HOSTING**

SLSS is offering Sydney Branch Clubs the opportunity to host the 2022 and 2023 Branch Championships.

The following pages outline the requirements which need to be considered by each Club interested in submitting an Expression of Interest (EOI).

#### **SPECIAL NOTE**

An alternate event format exists if the impact of COVID places restrictions on Surf Sports activities.

Restrictions will be guided by NSW Government Health Orders and advice should be sought from Local Council at the time of event planning.

## **EVENT FORMAT**

The Branch Championships Carnival will be held over two days each year:


#### **CONTINGENCY PLAN**

An alternative location for events must be included in the Host Club EOI in the event of adverse surf conditions in addition to a weather hold date for the following weekend.

## WORKFORCE REQUIREMENTS

In addition to other agreed event logistics, the Host Club must also be able to organise a workforce to cover:

- Deliver water, morning tea and lunches to Officials and Water Safety throughout the duration of the 'Event' (SLSS to supply)
- Attend to & resolve all logistical issues during the 'Event'
- Pack down all areas and have all gear returned in good order to the SLSS Branch Trailer at the conclusion of the 'Event'
- Provide traffic and trailer parking management.


## CLUB VENUE REQUIREMENTS

Provide a clean venue / clubhouse and promote only SLSS key Partners & Sponsors to their members and participants for the 'Event'.

An exclusive corporate function area in a prominent position with catering and bar facilities must be made available for the full two days for VIP Corporate Hospitality and Junior Lifesaver of the Year Presentations.







## HOST CLUB BENEFITS

By partnering with SLSS to deliver the Sydney Branch Championships, there are a range benefits including:

#### **CLUB CULTURE**

The opportunity for members to bond, build camaraderie and reputation - promoting the healthy development of surf sports in Sydney Branch.

#### **MEDIA**

The opportunity to be promoted within the community, which the Host Club can leverage to recruit new members and supporters.

#### **FUNDRAISING OPPORTUNITIES**

The Host Club will have the opportunity to engage in agreed fundraising activities for example through; a Club BBQ, Clubhouse bar facilities and event catering (subject to the specifications of the existing liquor licensing and public health orders).

### **SPONSORSHIP**

A naming rights event sponsor of the Surf life Saving Sydney Branch Championships is currently available.

Should Local Council or Clubs have business partners who wish to be involved in the Branch Championships, SLSS will consider the relevant options and can discuss in further detail.


SLSS will manage all Sponsors relating to the Branch Championships.

### **COUNCIL SUPPORT**

SLSS will work with the interested Host Club to gain Local Council support, essential to the running of the Championships. All agreements with Local Councils will be managed by SLSS.







### **EOI PROCESS**

#### **EVENT MANAGEMENT & DELIVERY**

SLSS will be responsible for the management and delivery of the event with the assistance of the Host Club and Local Council.

#### **SELECTION CRITERIA**

The successful EOI will primarily be determined on the suitability of the beach and surrounding areas to meet the carnival requirements, which includes relevant factors such as location, size, surf conditions as well Club and beach facilities.

In addition to other agreed event logistics, the Host Club must also be able to organise a workforce to cover:

- Two day beach and club use on selected dates (p5)
- Contingency/back up location identified (p5)
- Ability to provide Area Requirements (p6)
- Meet Workforce Requirements (p7)
- Ability to provide exclusive corporate function area (p7)
- General Council Support (p9)
- Ability to meet alternative COVID requirements (p13 &14)

The beach and Club venue must be exclusively available to SLSS for the carnival dates.

### **EOI FORMAT**

There is no required format for EOI's, however the submission should address all points on Page 10 under the Selection Criteria.

### **TIMELINE**

Expressions of Interest are open until 11.59pm Tuesday 9 November 2021. The SLSS Surf Sports Committee will review and supply shortlist recommendations to the SLSS Board of Management to invite the shortlisted club/s to a preliminary discussion.

An endorsement and Host Agreement will be formed no later than Tuesday 30 November 2021.

An alternate location must be included in the host clubs EOI in the event of adverse surf or weather.

#### **FINANCIAL**

In the event of a requirement for multiple host Clubs, a modified fee structure with a total value of \$15,000 + gst will be provided.
