The following is important LOGISTICS information in relation to the Surf Life Saving Sydney Branch SURF BOAT Championships events.

EVENT UPDATE

The current forecasted swell/weather conditions indicate that Elouera may not be suitable for the surf boat events on Saturday. The Safety Committee will conduct a check at 6am on Saturday morning and decide whether events will be moved to the contingency location of Kurnell. This will be announced on Team App (Surf Sports Sydney) and the Surf Life Saving Sydney facebook page.

COMMUNICATIONS

Sydney Branch will be using Stack Team App for communication throughout the event please request to join Surf Sports Sydney.

CARNIVAL LAYOUT

Please refer to the site map below as a guide, noting exact position will be as determined by Lifeguards on the day of the carnival.

There is a designated drop off/pick zone for unloading and loading Boats, and parking trailers during the carnival period. This is designed to allow for effective management of the parking areas and traffic management.

Trailer Unloading - Elouera

The drop off (6am to 8pm) / pick up (11am to 1pm) zone is located on the **EAST side (only)** of Mitchell Road, opposite Elouera Beach walkway 16 (pictured in site map below). Crews are to pull in parallel to kerb between the parking barricades. A marshal will be stationed at the drop off/pick up zone to assist. Trailers are then to be moved to the designated parking area. Crews are to utilise walkway 16 to access and leave the competition area.

Trailer Parking - Elouera

Trailers are to be parked in the sectioned off grassed area at corner of Hume Road and Mitchell Road – **NORTH side only** (pictured in site map below) for the duration of the carnival only (6am to 1pm).

Tent Areas - Elouera

There will be a marked-out area for club tents which will be designated by the Lifeguards on the morning of competition. Instructions on where to set up will be given on arrival.

Amenities - Elouera

Toilets and change room facilities are located at the southern end of Elouera SLSC. There will be no direct access provided to Elouera SLSC.

N.B. If there are circumstances that require an event attendee to enter the club they must adhere to Elouera SLSC COVID guidelines including using the QR sign in system.

Trailer Unloading - Kurnell (Contingency location)

The drop off (6am to 8pm) / pick up (11am to 1pm) zone is located on the **NORTH side (only)** of Prince Charles Parade, opposite Balboa Street (pictured in site map below). Crews are to pull in parallel to kerb heading east. A marshal will be stationed at the drop off/pick up zone to assist. Trailers are then to be moved to the designated parking area. Crews are to utilise walkway opposite Baloboa Street to access and



leave the competition area.

Trailer Parking - Kurnell (Contingency location)

Trailers can park in the car park at the Kurnell Boat ramp (pictured in site map below).

Amenities - Kurnell (Contingency location)

Toilets and change room facilities are located at the Bonna Point Reserve near the Kurnell Boat Ramp car park.

Tent Areas - Kurnell (Contingency location)

Please follow the instructions of the work party.

General Parking

All car parking will be in the surrounding public streets. Please ensure you allow sufficient time to park and arrive in time for registration. All vehicles must be parked legally at all times.

REGISTRATION & BRIEFINGS

Officials - Elouera

On arrival all appointed Officials are to register at the <u>Officials registration desk (located at Elouera SLSC) by 7:00am</u>, wearing their Official's uniform (shirt and hat). Officials yet to collect their uniform can do so at registration. Tea/coffee and light breakfast will be available at registration. Morning tea will be served on the beach.

Officials - Kurnell (Contingency location)



On arrival all appointed Officials are to register at the <u>Officials registration desk (located on the beach)</u> <u>by 7:15am</u>, wearing their Official's uniform (shirt and hat). Officials yet to collect their uniform can do so at registration. Breakfast snacks will be available at registration. Morning tea will be served on the beach.

Officials appointments are available on the **SLSS** website.

Wristbands - Elouera

Club registration opens at 6:30am and closes at 7:15am. A Club Representative will check in crews and collect wristbands for competitors from the registration area.

Wristbands – Kurnell (Contingency location)

Club registration opens at 6:45am and closes at 7:30am. A Club Representative will check in crews and collect wristbands for competitors from the registration area.

IRBs

Elouera and Cronulla IRB crews are rostered on for duration of the carnival.

POINTSCORE AND TEAM CHANGES

Sydney Branch will be running Pointscore via the SEMS Program

- The Opens point score will include Lifesaving events, Boats, R&R, March Past along with Water and Beach events.
- A Masters point score will include Water, Beach, and Boat events.
- The point system will work as follows: 6 points for 1st place and then down to 6th place which will be awarded 1 point. In the case of a tie, they will be awarded the same points and the next place will drop a position.

The Pointscore will be finalised at the conclusion of ALL Branch Championship Events.

Team Substitutions

For team events a substitution form is required (Finals only) Substitutions are be supplied to the Recorders prior to the final being held. No late fees will be charged for team event substitutions if the substitute is already entered into the carnival.

COVID SAFETY INFORMATION

It is essential that all attendees help maintain a COVID-safe environment by obeying the COVID safety directions from SLSS Staff and event Officials, and complying with the health directions of government and public health authorities issued at the time of the carnival.

Participants should not attend the Branch Championship Carnival

- ➤ If experiencing symptoms of COVID-19, including fever, cough, sore throat, shortness of breath, runny nose or loss of taste or smell.
- If test positive to PCR or RAT within the last 8 days.
- > If registered a positive RAT with NSW Health within the last 8 days.



> If home isolation has been advised by NSW Health following a positive PCR or RAT.

COVID-19 RULES FOR COMMUNITY SPORTS IN OUTDOOR AREAS

- As of 28 January 2022
- Community sports, including matches, competitions and training, can take place for all staff, spectators and participants.
- Anyone can participate in sport, exercise and outdoor gatherings
- Participants are not required to be fully vaccinated or carry vaccination evidence.
- COVID-19 Safe Check-ins are not required (except for gyms)
- · Face mask rules are not required in outdoors areas

COVID-19 RULES FOR ACTIVITIES IN INDOOR AREAS

- As of 28 January 2022
- COVID-19 Safe Check-in is required at all hospitality venues.
- At indoor venues the density limit of 1 person per 2 square meters applies.
- · Drinking indoors and outdoors may be seated or standing.
- Face masks are required, subject to exemptions.
- NSW Health strongly advise that patrons consider being seated while drinking.

Handwashing and Hygiene

All attendees are encouraged to frequently sanitise, using alcohol-based hand sanitiser or wash their hands with soap and water, especially before and after eating. Sanitiser will be readily available in the competition arena and at Elouera SLSC.

Physical Distancing

Attendees must be mindful to maintain social distancing keeping 1.5m from other persons, excluding field of play.

CONTINGENCY LOCATION

In the event that the surf conditions prevent the program being conducted at Elouera Beach, a decision will be made by the Safety and Competition Committee to move events to Kurnell Beach.

In the event that this decision is made, an announcement will be made to Team Managers onsite, and a notice placed on Team App.
