Surf Rescue 30 is pleased to hold an open day at 9am Saturday 8 October 2022. This day is being held to encourage and recruit new clubbies who want to see if they have what it takes to join Surf Rescue 30.

To join the group the new member must be:

- A Proficient and financial Member of ANY Surf Life Saving Club,
- At least Eighteen Years of Age
- Hold a current First Aid Certificate,
- Be Proficient in ART &
- SMAR trained (Desirable but not essential)

You must be physically fit, positive, outgoing and looking for adventure. There are great opportunities for you to receive commercial qualifications recognized by the Maritime Industry which could lead to other employment opportunities.

Once becoming a crewperson, we will look for you to roster on about 50 hours per season. This is important given the nature of our work as it requires a high level of proficiency which can only be achieved with familiarity. We believe a minimum of 50 patrol hours per season will allow you to maintain your skills.

We are a self-rostering Group whereby patrols are typically 8.30am to 1pm and 1pm to 6pm Saturdays, Sundays, and Public Holidays. These times vary with DST hours.

During this Open day potential recruits will be asked to get wet, jump off the rocks, swim to the boat, tread water etc.



Our Future.

Moving forward, Surf Rescue 30 will transition to a new Marine Rescue Randwick unit whereby we will be working in partnership with Surf Life Saving (utilizing a Rescue Swimmer – Surf Life Savers) on the vessel which will be under the control of Marine Rescue NSW. This is an exciting time for Surf Rescue 30, Marine Rescue NSW and SLSNSW – The future of this Group is looking extremely positive.
