RANDWICK SHIELD – Sunday 13 November 2022

Randwick Shield is a carnival for Nippers in the **U8's to U14's Age Groups** involving the Maroubra, South Maroubra, Coogee & Clovelly Surf Life Saving Clubs. This year after 2 year hiatus due to Covid, it is the turn of Maroubra SLSC to host the event at Maroubra Beach.

PLEASE NOTE THE RANDWICK SHIELD WILL BE RUN AS A SURF SPORT CARNIVAL. COMPETITION WILL COMMENCE AT 8:30AM AND TO FINISH AT 12PM (approximately)

Whilst this event is non-compulsory, the 4 participating clubs highly encourage a broad participation across their respective Nipper communities.

Please note - PARENTS MUST ATTEND AND SUPERVISE THEIR CHILD.

The Structure of the Day

The Randwick Shield has 3 parts:

- 1. 1km BEACH RUN Starts 7:00am, Marshal 6:30am
- 2. ALL AGE RELAY Starts 7:30am, Marshal at 7:15am
 - a) Only 2 x Teams per Club
 - b) Gender Balance Rules (Team A minimum 3 female competitors and Team B minimum 3 female competitors).
 - c) Age Group Rules All Teams must comprise 1 competitor from each Nippers Age Group from U9 through U14.
- 3. 'THE ROBBO RELAY' Relay (Gordon Wilson Memorial Trophy) Starts 8:00am, Marshal 7:45am.
 - a) Gender Balance Rules All Teams must comprise a minimum of 5 female competitors.
 - b) Age Group Rules -
- 4. Main Carnival Events Start 8:30am, Marshal 8:00am.



Main Carnival Event

There are swim, board, flags & sprint events for competitors to choose from —this is a competitive, fun carnival. Often events clash so it can be best to chat to your age group / child so that they can choose what they would like to compete in prior to the day to avoid disappointment. Officials cannot hold up events to accommodate competitors who want to compete across both Water and Sand Arenas.

Parking is always an issue so a good idea is to uber or arrive early for your events.

Each of the clubs will have their tents set up on the beach close to the walkway to Maroubra Club. Please ensure you arrive in good time to meet your Club coordinators so they can mark attendance and give your child a **stamp which they will require to enter the competition arenas**. Competitors should:-

- 1. Be dressed in full Nippers gear with their hat turned to show surf club colours
- 2. Have their Age Group written on their left upper arm.
- 3. Be stamped by their club coordinator to enable them to compete.

Organising and scheduling such a large group of children is a mammoth task. Organisers are at the mercy of the surf conditions and events can be delayed and/or cancelled at the last minute – this is to ensure safety of the children – the whole schedule can be disrupted. In this case, we ask all parents and nippers for their utmost respect and patience for the volunteers and officials. Due to large number of events and potentially variable surf conditions, the schedule can change/delay/cancel at any part of the day.

Conditions can be extremely hot so hats, long sleeve shirts, golf umbrella's, water and constant sunscreen application are a must for both nippers and parents.

Finally, events like this take a considerable amount of organising and we rely on our club volunteers, and you the parents, to help out on the day. Please consider how you may be able to help especially at the end of the day – pack up helpers are always needed and most welcome! This is a great community event with opportunity for us all to meet new people, make new friends, encourage our kids to have fun and keep the smiles on our faces!!



- Commences at 8.00am.
- There must be a minimum 5 females 5:6 split
- Minimum of 2 females to compete in water component
- Competitors must compete in their age group no running up.
- There are 11 competitors in this event.

Events	Descriptions and Rules					
U10 Flag	The event will commence with an U10 competitor completing a BEACH FLAG COURSE, picking up the baton and returning with the baton back past the start line and passing the baton to the U9 Sprinter					
II 19 Shrinter	The U9 sprinter positioned approximately 10 metres from the starting line from the beach flag event. The sprinter shall sprint 70 metres along the beach and shall then pass the baton to the U13 sprinter					
U13 Sprinter	The U13 sprinter shall then proceed over a 70 metre distance to the water's edge where the sprinter will tap the U8 wader					
II IX Waner	The U8 surf wade competitor will enter the water, into waist deep water, proceed along the oceanside of the wade course, cross the water finishing line and tap the U11 swimmer					
U11 Swimmer	The U11 swimmer who is positioned on the surf race start line will complete the SURF SWIM COURSE, return across the swim finishing line and tag the U11 sprinter					
U11 Sprinter	The U11 sprinter will then proceed along the beach and tag the U14 swimmer					
U14 Swimmer	The U14 swimmer who is positioned at the surf race starting line will complete the SURF SWIM COURSE, return across the swim finishing line and tag the YU14 sprinter					
U14 Sprinter	The U14 sprinter will then proceed along the beach and tag the U12 board paddler					
	The U12 board paddler who is positioned on the board race starting line with a board will complete the SURF BOARD COURSE, returacross the surf board finishing line in an upright position and in full control the board and tag the U12 sprinter					
U12 Sprinter	The U12 sprinter shall then proceed over a 70 metre distance to the waters edge and tag the U13 board paddler					
	The U13 board paddler is positioned on the board race starting line with a board will complete the SURF BOARD COURSE, return across the surf board finishing line in an upright position and in full control of the board and will cross the finish line
