Each of the clubs may have their tents set up on the beach close to the competition arenas. Please ensure you arrive in good time to get good parking.

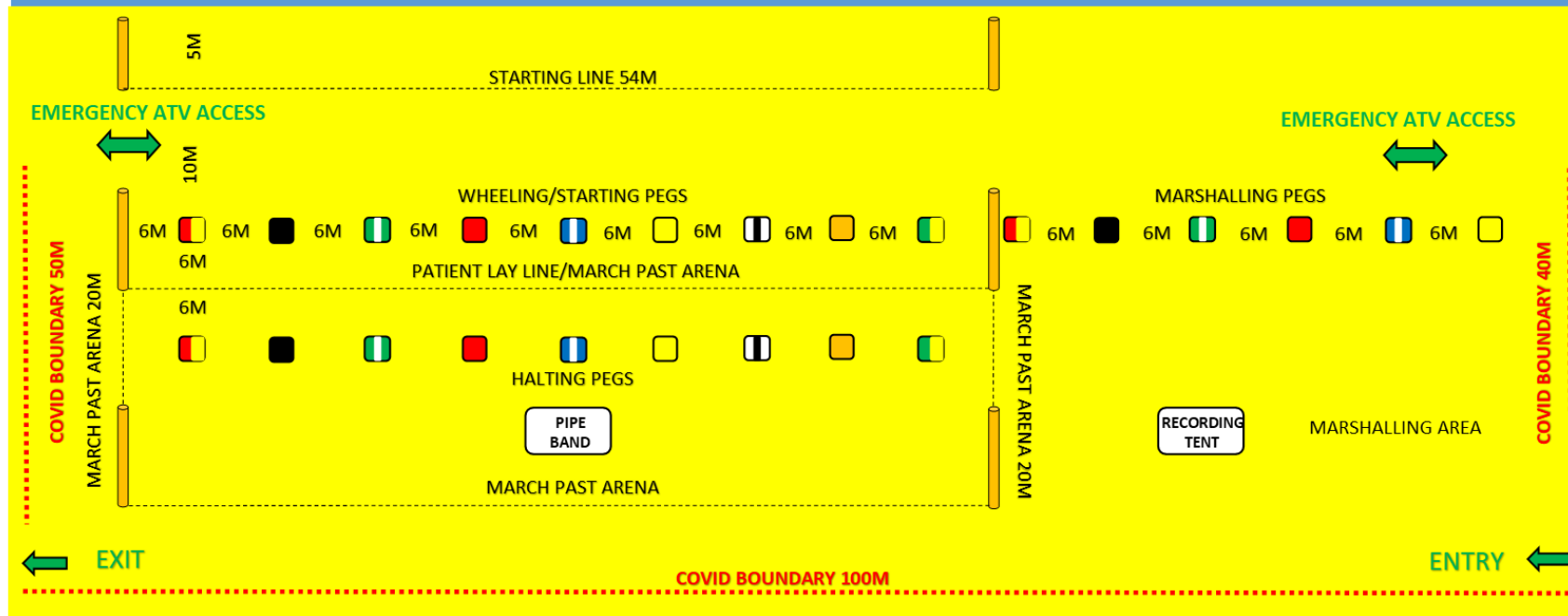
1. R&R teams competitors must be dressed in their preferably matching, pink vests and preferably matching, swim wear, with their numbered club caps.
