### **RULES AND CONDITIONS**

- 1. All competitors must be financial members of an SLSA Club and must be currently proficient.
- 2. Competitors must wear club caps & high-vis pink rash vests.
- 3. Handlers must wear club cap & high-vis vest.
- 4. Order of events can be changed at the discretion of the Carnival Committee and Carnival Referee on the day. The Carnival Committee reserves the right to cancel events.
- 5. The Water Safety Captain & Officials reserve the right to withdraw any competitor if their health or safety appears to be an unacceptable risk. The Water Safety decision will be final.
- 6. Competitors must not receive any outside assistance during the event.
- 7. The judge's decision will be final.
- 8. All competitors' boards must comply with the S.L.S. NSW Craft specifications.
- 9. u9-u15 Competitors can only compete in their own age group. They are not allowed to compete up in individual races.
- 10. All payments are NONREFUNDABLE.
- 11. Clubs will be required to provide water safety as per current SLSA Water Safety ratios.
- 12. Clubs are to submit entries online using the "SEMS" carnival manager system. This is accessed via https://sems.sls.com.au/. Please contact the SLSA IT Support via https://sems.sls.com.au/ for any user enquiries.
- 13. Event enquiries can be made to your individual club Surf Sports Directors.
- 14. Consistent with the SLSA Application for Membership form and declaration, photographs may be taken for promotional and historical purposes only. Participation is acknowledgement of acceptance of the consent to SLSA for this to occur.
- 15. Ohana Prize Packs for Top 5 finishers in each u9-u15 age group and gender.
- 16. \$500, \$300, and \$100 eftpos gift cards for 1st, 2nd, 3rd place respectively in u19 male and female races.
