IMPORTANT DATES & INFORMATION

- 1. Registration Closes Sunday 5 November 2023 11.59 pm
- 2. Minders TEAMS Meeting Wednesday 17 January 2024 7pm 8pm (meeting link will be shared direct to MINDERS after closing date)
- The bus will pick up camp attendees and their minders on the morning of Friday 9 February 2024 from 11am at North Bondi, then Maroubra and Elouera and drop off in the reverse order on the Sunday afternoon. Spaces are limited so get in early otherwise attendees with their parents, and/or Minders, will have to make their own way to the Camp. We will request transport details from attendees after the closing date.
- Please ensure the appropriate Age Managers get this Circular and further information regarding the Camp.
- Minders must:
 - 1. Be financial members of their club for the 2023-24 season.
 - 2. Hold the Age Managers Award as a minimum (recorded in Surfguard) and preferably be proficient holders of the SRC or Bronze; and higher qualifications are even more desirable.
 - 3. Have their current state government Working with Children Check clearance recorded in Surfquard.
 - 4. Have completed the Child Safe Awareness training module via the eLearning portal in the SLS members area.
- Once the Minders have been chosen by your Club, please ensure the Minders Information and also What to Bring to Camp documents are passed on.
- Camp Registration will be on the Friday 8 February 2024, at each of the bus pickup locations (North Bondi, Maroubra and Elouera) and at the camp for those that make their own way there.
- We will depart the camp at 3:00pm on Sunday 11 February 2024 and the bus will drop off at Elouera at approx. 3:45pm, then Maroubra and North Bondi.
- Should your club **NOT** be able to meet their number allowance, please advise us as soon as possible, as other clubs may be able to fill those spare spots.















Junior Development Camps Participants' Selection Criteria

- Longevity at Nippers when did they start? e.g. from U6's to now.
- Attitude at Nippers:
 - * positive attitude mentally, socially, physically and their behavior.
 - * being pro-active.
 - * do they listen, are they engaged, happy and good to work with?
- Focus on others and have a teamwork perspective as part of the group.
- A Good communicator with other Nippers and adults via different methods.
- Becoming a good Lifesaver in the future showing Leadership potential are they looking forward to being on Patrol? - will Patrol benefit from them being there?
- Abilities shown during lifesaving skills CPR training, rescues, etc.
- Ability to be effective and skilled in the water, on a board confident and enthusiastic.
- Part of a Team wanting to assist and learn at Nippers.
- Manage, lead, and assist others are you proud of them?
- Their Parents' involvement.

We suggest scoring each criterion out of 10 to give a final score out of 100.
