

## Junior Activity Chair Training



**Newly appointed** Junior Activity Chairs are required to attend and complete the SLSNSW JAC course. Club Nippers is unable to start if training not completed by JAC.

This 2023-2024 course will be held on Thursday 21st September.

**Returning JACs** must hold the Junior Activity Management Award, and whilst other members of their Junior Activity Team can also hold this award, they cannot be proxy for the Junior Activity Chair holding this award.


## Junior Development Resource Kit

The national Junior Development Program includes lessons and resources that are tailored to each different age group. The program covers a diverse range of skills and is based on participatory evaluation.

The program provides a pathway of learning towards the Surf Rescue Certificate and creating future lifesavers.

## Age Guides

The Age Guides are updated to reflect the most up to date teaching techniques, rules and relevance and lesson plans have been redesigned to ensure ease of use and interaction. They include lessons and resources that are tailored to each different age group.

The program covers a diverse range of skills from body surfing to catching waves on a board to First Aid, CPR and the surf environment.



## Junior Development Resources



Key updates in Junior Activities this season include:

- Clarification on moving up and down in nipper age
- Removal of continuous sequence in the preliminary skills evaluation
- Ability for clubs to enable accredited swim coach sign off on preliminary skills
- Addition of reasonable adjustments clarification to support club delivery

## Preliminary Skills and Award Completion



The Junior Preliminary Skills reflect industry standard research in aquatic skills, including greater focus on foundation skills in the water which assist in making rescue ready lifesavers.

The removal of the continuous skill sequence, also results in greater focus on floatation, submersion and propulsion.

In instances where evaluations cannot be completed by a Surf Life Saving member and to increase flexibility for clubs, a qualified and accredited swim coach can complete the evaluation by providing their ASTCA number and details.

## Junior Age Awards

It is recommended that nippers who complete 75% of nipper sessions (recorded in nipper attendance sheets or via the app) are eligible for the award and included in the award assessment request.

Award processing is done via a New Assessment Request in SurfGuard for each Award. Clubs must check that children are entered into the correct Award Assessment Request for their age group, and this may require clubs to check dates of birth.

#### **Certificate Format**

Clubs can choose 1 of 3 options for the issue of nipper certificates: hard copy posted to the club; PDF sent to the club for electronic distribution, or PDF emailed directly to the member. Clubs that do not nominate a preference to SLSNSW Training & Education Team, will have their certificates sent to them in hard copy.

## Age Managers Course

Course designed to equip Age Managers with the skills and knowledge needed to successfully carry out their role. All Age Managers **MUST** complete the SLSA Child Safe Awareness training, SLSA Age Manager Course, SLSNSW Age Manager Proficiency Video.

- 1. Child Safe Awareness training
- 2. Online Theory Course *Face to Face or Online*
- 3. Technical Session on the Beach
- 4. Mentoring Session on the Beach
- 5. Paperwork (Sign Off)
- 6. Award Allocation (Age Manager Course award)
- 7. Age Manager Proficiency Video (2023/24 Update)

## Age Managers Course Delivery



Age Manager Courses can be delivered at a club or branch level by an Age Manager Mentor.

Age Managers are encouraged to used skilled members to support content delivery – eg using Bronze Medallion holders, coaches, athletes, or members of the education team.

The Age Manager to Child ratio is 1:20 by age group (or stage).

## Age Manager Proficiency Video



For the 2023/24 season, SLSA has introduced an Age Manager Video 2023, required to be viewed annually via Members Area eLearning.

To access the video, please visit the Members Area eLearning platform and navigate to the 'Training Library' section. It is important to note that all Age Managers are required to complete the Age Manager Course and Child Safe Awareness Training to be an active Age Manager.

## Nipper App / SurfGuard Nippers Module



The Nipper 'App' is a platform to be introduced by SLSA, accessible via Members Area. Surfguard also has a new nipper's module for Junior Activity Chair management.

## Junior Activity Chairs can:

- Access a newly assigned permission area in SurfGuard Nippers module
- Manage and assign Age Manager access to the Nipper App
- Age Managers can access one or multiple age groups at the levels detailed below:

### Age Managers can:

- Manage Nipper Age Groups check in, check out, add notes, view nipper details
- View sessions attended and approve Nipper Age Group Awards and
- Approve preliminary and/or competition skills evaluations


**Nippers/Parents can:** view sessions attended, and awards gained via their Members Area.



## Junior Activity Search and Rescue



How would your club manage a missing nipper?

Do you know how to manage this search and rescue?

Have you practiced this scenario?

In all incidents where a search is required, the highest priority must be to focus on a safe and rapid response to commence the search.

Be prepared and have a current and practiced Junior Activity Search and Rescue plan and a search and rescue kit ready on the beach.

Further information can be found in SOPS (SLSNSW Standard Operating Procedures), or by speaking with the DoL (Director of Lifesaving) or CTO (Chief Training Officer) of each club.

Missing Nipper Aquatic Drills need to be booked in with Branch Office to be conducted before Christmas with Duty Officers present.

## 6. Additional Updates

#### **Junior Board Guide:**

- SLSA have updated and released the <u>Junior Board Guide</u> which is now available on the SLS NSW website.
- This is a good reference for when the tricky questions about Nipper surf boards come during the season.
- SLSA are working on updating the Surf Sports Manual and the JDR.

#### Nipper Come-and-try Update:

 SLSA are close to completing a Nippers Come-and-try Guide which we hope receive in time for the season.

#### **Special Event Applications:**

- SLS NSW require clubs to lodge an application for the purposes of insurance coverage for any special events that fall outside their regular training, lifesaving, or sporting activities described in the relevant manuals and SoP's.
- More information on these can be found on page 3 of the SLS NSW Pre-season Pack or on their website.



## 6. Additional Updates cont.

#### **Child Safety Coordinator:**

- This Season clubs are required to appoint a Child Safety Coordinator and list them in the officer position in SurfGuard.
- This club officer will be responsible for ALL their club's members under the age of 18 years, not just Nippers, and the role cannot be shared between clubs.
- Refer to the <u>Child Safe Coordinator</u> position description, etc. for this role in the Members section of the SLS NSW website.

#### Food Safety Supervisor (FSS):

- This Season volunteer organisations such as surf clubs that often serve food such as barbecues at events such as at Nippers, surf carnivals, etc. are required to appoint an FSS by 8 December 2023.
- This does not apply to operations such as kiosks that are already licensed food services providers.
- Further details on this can be found in the relevant section of the <u>NSW Food Authority</u> website.
- SLS NSW is preparing a guide for this for use this season.
