Dear RWC Operators

All operators are required to undergo the annual proficiency for the 2024 - 2025 season. This is necessary to maintain the high operator standard and to minimise the ongoing and sustained damages to craft and equipment resulting in costly repair bills.

The subject matter of the proficiencies will include all prerequisites for the RWC award including

- Bronze Medallion proficiency
- ART Proficiency
- RWC proficiency

These will be the only 4 dates that the RWC proficiency will be undertaken in Sydney Branch for season 2024-25. If you cannot attend any of the following dates due to extenuating circumstances but wish to patrol, please advise the RWC Coordinator via email prior to proficiency dates. Who needs to attend RWC Proficiency?

- All RWC operators are required to attend.
- Training positions can be rostered in Deputy for the dates above. Each day is limited to the number of positions in Deputy.
- The proficiencies will include demonstrated knowledge in all aspects of each award
- ART & Bronze medallion need to be undertaken prior to advancement onto the RWC
- Failure to complete a proficiency will result in operators being removed from the Branch RWC group and Deputy access for the 2024-2025 season.
