2. Competitors must wear club caps & high-vis pink rash vests.
3. Handlers must wear club cap & high-vis vest.
4. Order of events can be changed at the discretion of the Carnival Committee and Carnival Referee on the day. The Carnival Committee reserves the right to cancel events.
5. The Water Safety Captain & Officials reserve the right to withdraw any competitor if their health or safety appears to be an unacceptable risk. The Water Safety decision will be final.
6. Competitors must not receive any outside assistance during the event.
7. The judge's decision will be final.
8. All competitors' boards must comply with the S.L.S. NSW Craft specifications.
9. Competitors can only compete in their own age group. They are not allowed to compete up in individual races.
10. All payments are NON-REFUNDABLE.
11. Clubs will be required to provide water safety as per current SLSC Water Safety ratios.
