3. ENTRY FEES:

4. LATE ENTRIES

4.1 Late entries will be taken on the day with a fee of \$25 per competitor. If a member is unable to be entered into Carnival management system on the day of entry, their entry may not be accepted.

5.1 The South Maroubra U8 Carnival will be conducted over 1 round and open to any SLSA financial and proficient member.

6.1 Team Relays

6.2 Count back

In the circumstance of two or more competitors finishing on equal points in the overall pointscore, a countback will occur to determine which competitor receives the higher placing in the overall pointscore. The countback will be awarded to the competitor who has the highest individual event placing or number of placings. If both competitors have the same number of highest placings (e.g. three 1st places in individual round events) then the next highest position (e.g. number of 2 placings) will be used to separate the competitors.

8. PROGRAM:

- 8.2 Events will be conducted as per the current SLSA Surf Sports Manual Edition and any additional bulletins.
- 8.3 It will be up to the discretion of the Carnival Referee if events go ahead or be changed.
