I am writing to extend my heartfelt thanks to each and every one of you for your unwavering dedication and service over the Easter long weekend. As you know, this period presented some particularly challenging circumstances, and your professionalism, resilience, and teamwork did not go unnoticed.

Tragically, we witnessed the loss of a rock fisherman at Wattamolla and the ongoing search for a 24year-old male still missing after an extensive operation at Little Bay. These incidents have weighed heavily on our community, and our thoughts are with the families and loved ones affected by these tragedies.

In the face of such heartbreaking events, your efforts in responding to these incidents, providing support, and maintaining a high standard of care reflect the true spirit of Surf Life Saving. The search and rescue operations, especially in these difficult conditions, demonstrated not only your skill and expertise but also your profound commitment to saving lives.

It was incredibly pleasing to see that our operations were able to continue at such a high level of efficiency and effectiveness. The RWC service was staffed at over 80% of its rostering capacity, and I am especially proud to report that Surf Rescue 30 was fully rostered throughout the weekend. Additionally, our Duty Officer team went above and beyond in assisting with the searches, with many members rostering beyond their normal requirements to ensure that our response was swift and comprehensive. Not to mention the countless rescues and preventative actions conducted by our 15 Clubs in preventing further tragedies in such difficult conditions.

Your hard work and commitment did not go unnoticed, and I have received messages of thanks from several distinguished individuals, including Steve Pearce, CEO of Surf Life Saving NSW, Jihad Dib, NSW Minister for Emergency Services, and Peter Agnew, President of Surf Life Saving NSW. They have all expressed their appreciation for your outstanding contributions during this challenging time.
