

1.2 SAFETY OVERVIEW – Culture of Safety and Child Safety

- At our core we are a Safety Organisation.
- Creating a culture of safety with our members helps us to keep in front of our minds, that safety of the public and our members is our priority.
- Online SLS Child Safe Awareness Training has been mandated for Club and Branch
 Officers, MPIOs and complaint handlers, Age Managers, Coaches and Officials, Patrol
 Captains, Trainers, Assessors and Facilitators, and is being recommended to cover ALL
 remaining patrolling members this season and to become mandatory next season.
- We also recommend that ALL Watersafety Personnel, that aren't necessarily Patrolling Members, should also undertake this.
- Child Safety pertains to ALL members under 18 years of age, not just Nippers.
 SLSA Child Safety Policy Signage
- SLSNSW have advised they are preparing a set of various posters for use by clubs in different scenarios (including change rooms), with some simple messages.
- They are scheduling these to be available during Child Protection Week in early September.

 Championship event to encourage further engagement in the pool rescue events at a local level.





5. Carnival Preparations & Processes

Forms and Notifications Required:

- Notify SSC of intentions to run any event/carnival/training day
- Safety Forms to be completed and provided to Sydney Branch
- Council Application Forms & Beach Bookings to be completed and provided to Sydney Branch & Relevant Council
- Special Event Request Forms to be completed and provided to Sydney Branch for endorsement.
- Sydney Branch will forward relevant forms after endorsement through to NSWSLS
 as relevant and required. Any forms sent to SLSNSW without the proper
 endorsement from Sydney Branch will not be approved.
- Gear Trailer requirements & hire requests (as required)
- Safety & Risk for carnivals and requirements

7. Officials Updates

Quota

To assist the operation of carnivals in a safe and efficient manner, to align with State
Championships and assist Clubs fulfil obligations, Sydney Branch will be implementing a
quota system this season based on the number of entries and discipline type. Like with State
Champs, failure to fulfil will result in the immediate suspension of said Club and possible
further action, including monetary and/or points.

Accreditation


- Branch is committed to assisting Clubs readily attain their quota of accredited officials.

9. General Business and Q&A

- Question from Max Gonzalez regarding Lifesaving clinics and timetable to ensure improvement on last season Branch Championships
 - Thankyou Max, Andrew Bloxsom is working on the program and ensuring we will not have a repeat of last season Branch Championships for the Lifesaving events
 - I will have Andrew reach out to you to discuss potential clinics for the season and also discuss the plans for the programming at the Sydney Branch Championships for lifesaving event.
- Safety & Risk
 - Zero tolerance for officials abuse this season, clubs will be potentially removed from the carnival if there are incidents at carnivals
 - Quota enforcement and potential removal from carnival with non-supply of quotas for carnival from clubs. Such as water safety, IRB, Officials etc.
- Interbranch Trial at Sydney Water will there be a discounted entry fee for one carnival?
 - Yes I will reach out to Sydney Water organisers for a special rate for the Sydney Branch athletes for Round 1 at a discounted rate for one round. I will communicate details once confirmed with Sydney Water organisers. This will also be included in the circular.
